Please help us furnish our new dome spaces to make them cozy particularly for our new community educational venture at Harmony, Tallulah's Wild PLAYce! It's our intergenerational, Afrocentric, Indigenous centric, agroforestry, agricultural, homeschool nature laboratory! Ya heard!

As is the purpose of our existence as an organization, Harmony Homestead and Wholeness Center welcomes the newness of collective regenerative thought and ways of being together that put the vibrance of the Earth, black elders and children at the center of service and celebration.

We hold space for black lives mending from the spiritual, mental, and physical abuses we, as Black staff and volunteers here, know all too well. As before, we will organically grow, culturally celebratory foods for BIPOC and hold sacred space for our sacred lives.

Highlights from our 2023 growing season: We grew at least 1000 lbs of organically grown food and fed Black elders, families, and churches in Berkshire, Albany, Rensselaer, and Schenectady

Counties for free (by donation). We grew hundreds of seedlings/starter plants distributed to the explosion of community self-empowerment bursting all around in BIPOC communities. We held weekly meditation, prayer, and gospel singing to help us thrive through challenging times. What a both excruciating and exhilarating time to be alive, be inspired, and be committed to self-love and communal restoration!

Additionally, we continued the deep honor of growing a food and medicinal Ancestral Arboretum! With this arboretum we feed the people, honor the ancestors and trees, and heal the land.

We'll also continue to repair and strengthen our infrastructure with more rainwater catchment, irrigation, and creating sacred sanctuaries for the community.

We welcome your resources and hands to come dig holes for trees, weed, seed, feed the Earth and her peoples.
