# RAMP Registration Guide

Alberta Alpine's fee structure has changed. All clubs in the province have been asked to use the platform RAMP for 2023/2024 AASA season fees. Next season, RAMP will become mandatory for <u>all</u> clubs in the province.

Please use this guide to navigate the registration process.

### 1. Create a RAMP account.

Only create one account per family.

## 2. Create a profile for each family member.

a) "Add an Account Member" and create an individual profile for **each** family member (each parent/guardian and each athlete(s) must have their own profile). (image 2.1)

Note: You do not need to create a profile for siblings who do not ski race.

Note: Any additional family members or friends who plan to <u>volunteer</u> at an event this season **must** have a profile




b) Provide the following information: name, birthdate, gender, address, cell phone, and email. (image 2.2)


Note: Please use the cell phone and email address for the primary parent on athlete profiles.

c) Do not provide the following information: respect in sport certificate, NCCP, photo, birth certificate, government issued id, vss file, crc file, proof of residency, or treaty/status/Metis card. (image 2.2)

d) Once you have registered all your family members, your account should look like image 2.3 below!

<u>PLEASE</u> double check that every family member's personal information (name, DOB, gender, etc.) is inputted correctly.

Now you are ready to register with Alberta Alpine! See step 3.

## 3. Registration Process: ATHLETES

**Note:** PLEASE double check that your athlete's data has been entered correctly. Mistakes could prevent your athlete from being able to register and participate in a race.

a) Each athlete must be registered as a "participant". (image 3.1)

b) Choose your season, account member, and division. (image 3.2)

Season: "AASA 2023-2024 FOR DIRECT REGISTRATION ONLY"

Account Member: Choose the athlete you wish to register.

<u>Division:</u> Your athlete's division is based on their birth year. Please make sure your athlete's division is correct. They can only participate at races in the division they are registered for.

#### Division Options are:

• U8- Entry Level: Born 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019

Note: "U8 – Entry Level" encompasses both **Dream Team/U6** (2018/19) and **U8** (2016/17)

• U10 – Entry Level: Born 2014, 2015

• U12 – Recreational: Born 2012, 2013


• U14 – National Card: Born 2010, 2011

• U16 - National Card: Born 2008, 2009

• 16-21 – National Card: Born 2005, 2006, 2007


Note: Because this registration is with AASA, it does not matter if the athlete is in regional or provincial or flex or full time or Entry level or National Card. It only matters what age division (i.e. U8 or U14) they are in.

Every athlete MUST choose the only package option below regardless of division: "2023/2024 Athlete Registration" for \$0.00. (image 3.3)



The fees you pay to Alberta Alpine are dependent on your athlete's age division (plus RAMP and administration fees).

- U6 / U8 pay \$150/per athlete
- U10 pay \$187/per athlete
- U12 pay \$193/per athlete
- U14 pay \$310/per athlete
- U16 pay \$310/per athlete
- U19 (16-21) pay \$310/per athlete


c) Press the 'continue' button at the bottom of the page to **check-out and pay** for your athlete's Alberta Alpine season registration. (image 3.4)



#### **Concussion Policy for Consent**

Any Alberta Alpine Ski Association (AASA) athlete under the age of 18 years suspected of having sustained a concussion/traumatic brain injury must be removed immediately from participation in AASA sporting event (e.g. sanctioned training, practice, camps, competitions or tryouts), by the Technical Delegate or AASA member coach overseeing such sporting event. The minor athlete will be prohibited from further participation until evaluated and cleared in writing to resume participation in AASA sporting events by a qualified health care provider trained in the evaluation and management of concussive head injuries. The health care professional must certify to AASA in the clearance letter that he/she has successfully completed a continuing education course in the evaluation and management of concussive head injuries within three years of the day on which the written statement is made.

Upon removal of a minor athlete from participation for a suspected concussion/traumatic brain injury, the AASA TD or member coach making the removal must inform AASA Member Services. Athletes who have subsequently been medically cleared to resume participation must provide such medical clearance (as described above) to AASA Member Services in order to be permitted to participate in AASA sporting events.

#### **About Concussion**

A concussion is a type of traumatic brain injury (TBI) caused by a bump, blow, or jolt to the head. Concussions can also occur from a fall or a blow to the body that causes the head and brain to move quickly back and forth. Doctors may describe a concussion as a "mild" brain injury because concussions are usually not life-threatenina. Even so, their effects

Congrats! Your athlete is now registered with Alberta Alpine. Repeat the process (including payment of Alberta Alpine fees) for each additional athlete you need to register. Once you are complete, move on to step 4.

# 4. Registration Process: PARENTS (or guardians)

a) Parents/guardians are registered as either: 1. Officials

or

2. Executives/Volunteers

(refer to image 3.1)

**Both parents/guardians** of the athlete must be registered with Alberta Alpine for the season.

Each individual parent/guardian will register as an official OR executive/volunteer (not both).


- ➤ If the parent/guardian has taken their level 1, 2, 3 or TD officials certification: they will register as an official (proceed to step b).
- ➤ If the parent/guardian has not taken an officials certification course: they will register as an executive/volunteer (proceed to step c).

b) Register as an official. Choose your season, account member, and division. (image 4.1)

Season: "AASA 2023-2024 FOR DIRECT REGISTRATION ONLY"


<u>Account Member:</u> Choose a parent/guardian to register. **Both** parents/guardians must register with Alberta Alpine for the season.

Officiating Level: Choose the highest level of officials certification the parent/guardians had completed (Level 1, 2, 3 or TD).





Register the next parent/guardian as either an official (repeat step b) or an executive/volunteer (step c).


Once both parents/guardians have registered, move onto step 5.

c) Register as an executive/volunteer. Choose your season, account member, and division. (image 4.4)

Season: "AASA 2023-2024 FOR DIRECT REGISTRATION ONLY"

Position: "General Member (PARENT/GUARDIANS)"

<u>Account Member:</u> Choose a parent/guardian to register. **Both** parents/guardians must register with Alberta Alpine for the season.

Press the 'continue' button at the bottom of the page to sign waivers/consent/acknowledgment. (image 4.2)

Check-out and pay for parent/guardian Alberta Alpine season registration. (image 4.3)

Register the next parent/guardian as either an official (step b) or an executive/volunteer (repeat step c).

Once both parents/guardians have registered, move onto step 5.

## 5. Registration Process: **NOT** PARENTS (or guardians)

Any additional family members (such as aunts, uncles, grandparents) or friends who plan to volunteer at races or participate in Alberta Alpine sanctioned events **MUST REGISTER** with Alberta Alpine for the 2023/24 season.

Most common examples include family members or friends who:

- Plan to volunteer at a race.
- Help the Dream Team program on a Tuesday or Sunday when a parent cannot step in.
- Participate in an Alberta Alpine sanctioned event (including training or races) in <u>any</u> capacity (the exception being a public spectator).

If they have taken their level 1, 2, 3, or TD officials certification, please register them as an official.

If they have not taken any officials certification, please register them as an executive/volunteer (under "POSITION" please choose "NOT parent/guardian").
