**Station Ideas Update:** Chief has talked with TCA Architects, who helped with the station in Belgrade. They have submitted a project scope for our review, and is waiting for approval from the board to continue and then would provide pricing information. **The board agreed to proceed with this and get cost information.** 

**Brush 426:** We have the offer from Ford to contribute \$7,000 towards the cost of a replacement engine, leaving us the balance of \$14,800. This would have a 2-year warranty and repairs would need to be done at Beartooth Ford. Tonya estimates the resale value (with the new engine) would be about \$35,000. It may take a while for a new engine to be delivered if we decide to replace it. Replacing the engine would give us several options: Use it in service – the mechanic at Beartooth Ford thinks it would be good for a "normal life span" if we do the emissions deletes right away; Sell it once it's running

again and be done with it; Use for a while and sell it later; Use it until it dies again and be done. Debbie moved to replace the engine and decide later what to do. Brent seconded the motion. John opposed, motion carried. Chief will find out from Tonya how long the offer from Ford is valid.
