

Birds Chair- Job Description

The Chair is responsible for informing Club members each month about any interesting local or national information regarding birds. This information can be presented orally or with handouts for members to take home for reference.

Responsibilities:

- Information may be regarding unusual bird sightings locally, spring and fall migration, feeding of birds, types of feeders to use, types of plants to use in the garden to attract birds, names of local rehabilitators for birds in the event a bird is injured in the garden area, local lectures about birding or bird walks as they occur.

Chair may also work with program chairperson to suggest programs on birds that could be presented to the club, e.g. Hope Douglas from "Wind Over wings". The D.E.P. and CT Audubon have speakers available for lecture series.
