The Chair of the Broad Street Decorating Chair is responsible for getting members to volunteer to create evergreen wreaths for the doors of the homes on Broad Street. "The decorating of Broad Street is the Guilford Garden Clubs' gift to the town".

## Responsibilities:

- 1. Encourage garden club members to sign up to decorate a door(s) with a wreath or swag.
- 2. Provide a sign-up sheet at both the October and November board and general meetings (see attached sign-up sheet showing the list of homes with owner(s) names and addresses and any special requirements, e.g. two wreaths required for double doors, etc.) Additionally, a current picture of each house door will be with the sign-up sheet.
- 3. In late October or early November, send a letter to each homeowner on Broad Street (see attached letter).
- 4. Prior to sending the letter, check that current homeowners have not changed from previous year. This can be achieved by:
- Town Hall records
- Yellow pages.com
- Call the owners
- If all else fails, call the next door neighbors.
- 5. Personalize letters to each homeowner on Guilford Garden Club stationary including the name and address as well as their first names, if known. This information, saved on your computer, can be used to make changes to dates, etc. as needed. Include your name, (Guilford Garden Club Door Chair), address and phone number at the bottom of the letter for

homeowners to have a point of contact. Your will most likely receive up to a month or two after the wreaths have been placed on the door.

- 6. Forward checks, with any letter received from the homeowners to the treasurer; report any comments at the next board meeting; request corresponding secretary to promptly send note thanking homeowner for their donation, and also for their continued support of Christmas on Broad Street.
- 7. Provide pictures of houses and doors at the workshop for club members who have volunteered to decorate a door or doors. This will help them in decorating their wreath(s) to match the house and door. Provide pictures for the Yearbook.
- 8. Remind volunteers that the wreaths will be viewed by most people from the sidewalk or street; therefore, the decorations must work from both up close, as well as from the street.
- 9. Verify that all wreaths have been made by Wednesday morning.
- 10. Remind each wreath maker that all wreaths must be hung no later than noon on Thursday. If a house has been renovated, they need to check with the homeowner as to how the wreath should be hung (heavy duty green floral wire is likely to be used to hang wreaths).
- 11. Provide assistance to any wreath maker experiencing problems with hanging their wreath(s).
