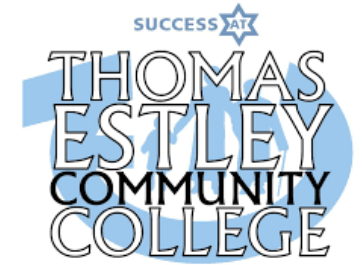


GCSE (9–1) History B: The Schools History Project
