

SUNDOWNERS SNOWMOBILE CLUB ANNUAL \$500 SCHOLARSHIP

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be high school graduates and enrolled/participating in some kind of post-secondary training or education program (e.g., technical school, college, etc.). Continuing students are also eligible, not only recent high school graduates.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The simple application for this scholarship will consist of three parts:

1. Complete the Applicant Information sheet (below, but link will be provided on web site and Facebook page).
2. Write an essay explaining your connection to the Sundowners Snowmobile Club. For example, you and/or your parents are members, our trail runs through a family member's farm, etc. Please expand and explain as much as you can, rather than submitting just a brief statement. The essay may be as long or as short as you feel necessary to completely make your point. Obviously, the extremes (very long or very short) should be avoided.
3. Include a copy of your grade report or transcript showing the immediate prior term (such as fall semester or equivalent). If the program you're in doesn't provide such documents, any reasonable form of proof of successful progress will be accepted.

Applications must be postmarked by February 15.

SELECTION PROCESS

The winner will be selected by the Board of Directors of Sundowners Snowmobile Club, based on the strength of the essay. Applications may be disqualified if incomplete.

The successful applicant will be announced at the March Sundowners meeting and a check for \$500 will be sent to the winner.
