Bitches in season: Refund of all but \$5.00 of entry fee will be made if bitches come into season after entries close. Request in writing for refund must be submitted to the show secretary with a certificate from a veterinarian before the start of the show.

All entries must be submitted on official AKC entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are not acceptable.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

THE TRIAL SITE will be available at 7:45 am.

CRATING in designated areas only. CRATE SPACE IS LIMITED. X-pens will not be allowed in the building. Dogs must be removed from the Trial site immediately following the conclusion of the judging every night. No dogs may be left in building overnight. There will be no space for un-entered dogs

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH BY THE HANDLER OR CONFINED TO THEIR CRATES except when being judged.

Dogs may not be on Flexi-Leads or long leads while in the building. No prong collars.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

No RV or Overnight parking available at the Trial Site. See list of accommodations for details on RV parking

ENTRY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED at the bottom by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise entry cannot be accepted.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS to entry forms must be received in writing or by e-mail prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners and handlers are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such error or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please print plainly or type all information on your entry to help avoid errors.

A RECORDING FEE of 50 cents and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee are required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test.

This Recording Fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only (AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2).

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.

If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies and the dictates of law enforcement or the owners of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to

snowstorms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facility or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund will be made. POST DATED CHECKS AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as practicable after entries close with confirmation and judging programs. Should such acknowledgement not be received by exhibitor within a reasonable amount of time, please notify Trial Secretary.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring at their scheduled time. Judges will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule.

Every effort will be made to accommodate handlers with multiple dogs in the same class.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal & external parasites, communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations

WAIVER OF RIGHTS-ANIMALS IN DISTRESS

Augusta Kennel Club, Inc. reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate. All persons attending these dog events hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal. The club regards the health, safety and life of any dog on the show grounds to be paramount to other property or privacy rights.

RALLY TRIAL: TRANSFER FORM

Present this form to the Trial Secretary or the Superintendent at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

Refer to the Rally Regulations – Chapter 1, Section 15, Transfers.

- The club will clearly state in its premium list whether transfers will or will not be allowed. If no statement is provided in the premium list the default is to allow transfers.
- A transfer from a rally class to a rally class may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible and the club offers transfers.
- Transfers from an "A" to "B" class at the same level are allowed provided the host club allows transfers. *(When a club does not allow transfers, refer to Section 16.)*
- The request for transfer must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- Clubs may also choose to accept transfers prior to the day of the trial, and this should be clearly stated in the premium list.
- Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
