Glover Scholarship Auditions

The Glover Scholarship Auditions were held on April 9, 2022 at Monumental United Methodist Church in Portsmouth. We had nine teachers enter students this year. Thirty eight students were registered and thirty seven auditioned. Twenty two students won a monetary award within grades 5 through 8. These awards included a first place of \$400, a second place of \$350, and a third place of \$300 in each school grade. A total of ten honorable mention awards of \$175 were also given. Teachers who had student winners include Susan Atkins, Joan Edwards, Donna Halleck, Mun Lee Han, Lynn Kleisler, Mary Ann Medlin, Josephine Jones and Elizabeth Smith.

A Joan Moore Memorial Award is given yearly to a deserving eighth grader that auditioned in this event due to donations given in her name to honor her. Joan Moore was one of the first to be on the Glover Scholarship Auditions Committee and was a friend of David Carr Glover as well as worked for him during her music career. The teacher of the student who received this \$100 award this year is Joan Edwards.


