Jordan Kitt's Music returns to Tidewater! After over 40 years in business, Piano & Organ Warehouse has been acquired by Jordan Kitt's Music.

Jordan Kitt's had a long and wonderful history in the Tidewater market, starting with the acquisition of Temple of Music in 1988 from then-owner Joe Riddle. Over the years, "Jordan Kitt's Temple of Music" had stores in Pembroke Mall, Lynnhaven Mall, Coliseum Mall, and most recently a free standing location on Virginia Beach Boulevard. Jordan Kitt's exited the market in 2010. During that time, Jordan Kitt's best competitor in Virginia Beach was Piano & Organ Warehouse, the Yamaha dealership owned by well-respected industry veterans Buddy and Peggy Parker.

Chris Syllaba, Jordan Kitt's President, states: "We are so excited to be back in Virginia Beach, serving the entire Tidewater market with major brands like Yamaha, Cristofori and Roland. We are also looking forward to again being able to support the Tidewater Music Teachers Forum and education outreach in all of Hampton Roads."

The entire current staff will continue on in their roles under the leadership of *Ray Barker*, District Manager. Ray has had a long and successful career in the piano business, having started selling Yamaha pianos in 1996 for Piano & Organ Warehouse. He then managed the Jordan Kitt's Temple of Music store for several years before returning to Piano & Organ Warehouse in 2010.

Current piano inventory from Piano & Organ Warehouse is now being liquidated during a store closing sale before the location is re-branded as Jordan Kitt's Music.
