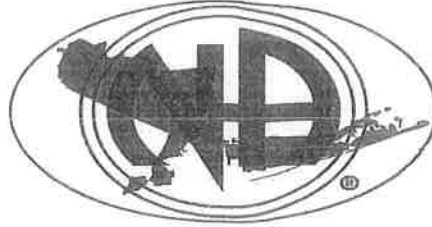

For May 2017 Regional Session

The BoD has spent the past two months doing the following:

1. Sent letters to approximately 70 areas in NJ, CT, MA, RI, NH, ME, and VT inviting them to purchase lit from us
2. Adding to our growing stock of non-NAWS merchandise: a new H&I t shirt, our own Steps and Traditions posters, a "beanie" that will be debuted at the Brooklyn Convention
3. Generating ideas for more non-NAWS merchandise: bumper stickers and umbrellas, for example
4. Looking for Regional events for July, August, and September where we can sell our merchandise
5. Gearing up to sell merchandise at Kings Bay anniversary and Brooklyn convention
6. The NJ Regional Convention Committee has ordered lit from us for their upcoming convention and it has been delivered to them
7. We have added to the regional website an insurance page with FAQs and an interactive insurance certificate request form. This is where you find it:

8. Re-organizing the store, especially its shelves, for maximum efficiency and space-saving (we invite the RCMs for a quick tour of the new layout)
9. Turning the space by the former entrance to the old conference room into a storage closet for our lit
10. Updated our inventory when we activated our new transactional and accounting systems
11. Designed a new logo for GNYR merchandise, which we are asking the Region to accept as the official GNYR logo, so that we can implement it everywhere our logo currently displays
12. We have not yet gotten any new volunteers since March's regional session. We are including with this report, a mock-up of what a full volunteer schedule could look like.
13. The BoD supports the nomination of John B who is submitting his resume today to join the Board as a Director
14. We have updated the Convention Committee Policy and Guidelines as per the directions given to us at the March Regional session (sent with latest BoD Minutes and notification of next BoD meeting by Ed W)

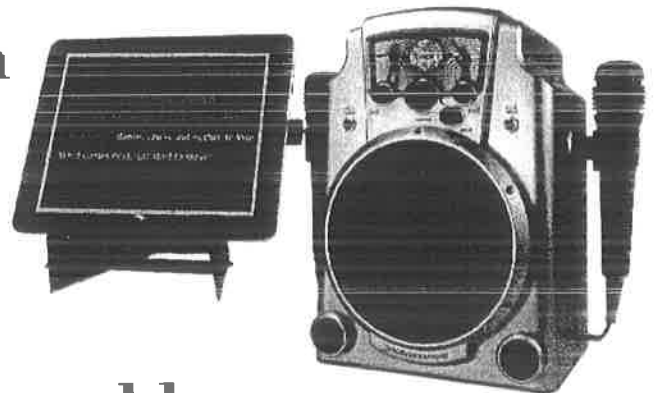

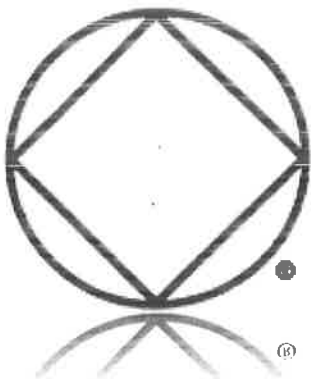

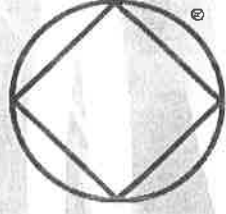
