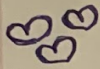

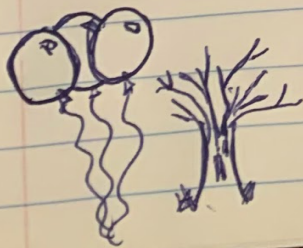
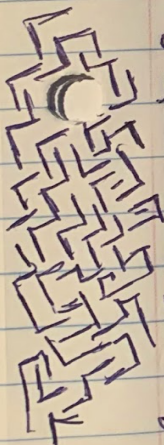

- Zonal Forums
- Regions combine into **Zonal Forums** to better serve their member communities.
- **Zonal Forums** inside the United States and Canada bring together collections of states and provinces. **Zonal Forums** worldwide bring together communities of nations.

There are twelve zonal forums throughout the world.

The forums of Europe, Asia-Pacific and Latin America serve as focal points for fellowship development within these communities.

Our own zonal forum -- the Northeast Zonal Forum (NEZF) -- includes fourteen regions from the northeast United States. It is a large, diverse, and populous community of recovering addicts.

The Northeast Zonal Forum has primarily been devoted to issue discussion.

Like many other forums in and outside the U.S., it has also developed service functions.

- Almost all host multi-regional workshops on a variety of topics.
- Some host multi-regional assemblies.

Zonal forums work closely with NA World Services to provide guidance and to encourage the growth of new NA communities in their sections of the world.
