Services and Operations OFA ophthalmology examination, OFA patella examination, OFA hip radiographs, anesthesia, magnetic resonance imaging (MRI)

Client recommendations and/or explanation of diagnosis or problems

Kingsley presented to Iowa State University Lloyd Veterinary Medical Center on 01/23/14 for evaluation.

He was seen by the ophthalmology, orthopedic surgery, neurology, anesthesia, and radiology departments.

PROCEDURES:

- His eyes were dilated and an OFA ophthalmic examination was performed.
- His knees (patellas) were palpated by the orthopedic surgery department for OFA examination.
- He was placed under general anesthesia and radiographs for OFA hip evaluation were taken.
- While under general anesthesia, magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) was performed to evaluate for occipital malformation and associated syringomyelia (SM).

ASSESSMENT:

- Ophthalmology: pronounced lens sutures in both eyes, mild vitreal in both eyes, mild ventromedial entropion in both eyes
- Orthopedic surgery: normal right and left patellas
- Neurology: MRI revealed he did have a malformed occipital cranial bone, but there was no associated syringomyelia
- Radiology: OFA hip radiographs were sent off, for evaluation by certified OFA radiologists.
