Al and Carol Nibbelink would like to thank everyone for all the prayers, visits, food, texts and calls! We appreciate you all and may the Lord bless you!!

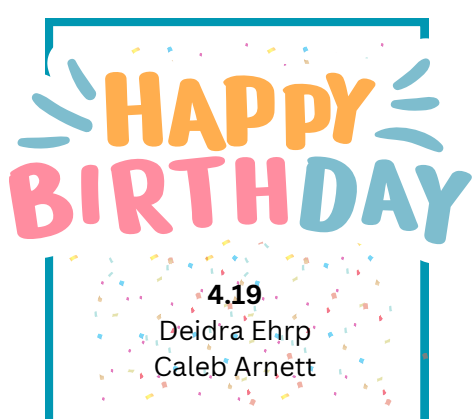
Rejoice that Ike Huizenga returned home on Monday from the hospital and is doing well.
