Psalms 91

<u>1 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.</u>

<u>2 I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.</u>

<u>3 Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome</u> <u>pestilence.</u>

<u>4 He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth</u> <u>shall be thy shield and buckler.</u>

5 Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day;

<u>6 Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth</u> <u>at noonday.</u>

7 A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; *but* it shall not <u>come nigh thee.</u>

8 Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked.

<u>9 Because thou hast made the LORD, *which is* my refuge, *even* the most High, thy <u>habitation;</u></u>

<u>10 There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.</u> 11 For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.

<u>12 They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone.</u>

<u>13 Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou</u> trample under feet.

<u>14 Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name.</u>

<u>15 He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.</u>

16 With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.
