Greeting Faith Family,

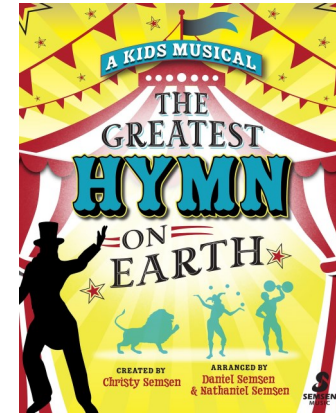
