1515 Earl Armstrong Plan of Subdivision Public Meeting - Sept 20, 2022

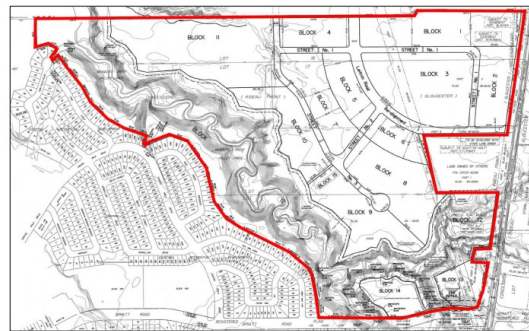


The City of Ottawa will hold a Public Meeting on Tuesday, September 20, 2022 at 6:30pm through Zoom (video conferencing) to discuss a proposed plan of subdivision.

The subdivision application has been submitted to permit the development of 1 new public road that will connect Earl Armstrong Road to Limebank Road, and for 3 development blocks for commercial and retail development. The proposed development would permit the future development, through the site plan control process, of 12 buildings with associated surface vehicular and bicycle parking. Landscaping around and within the site is proposed, as is a pedestrian connection at the north of the site to connect with the pathway around the storm water management pond.

Plan of Subdivision and Zoning By-law Amendment at 3700 Twin Falls and 4020 Spratt Road



The City of Ottawa has received a Zoning By-law Amendment and Plan of Subdivision application to develop a plan of subdivision for an employment business park, with out parcels for residential and institutional uses. The plan includes the retention of an open space corridor for Mosquito Creek.

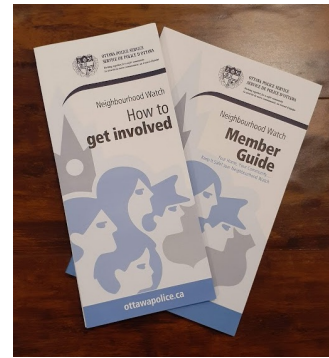
