PARISH REGISTRATION AND THE ART OF BUILDING A COMMUNITY OF FAITH

We are already in full throttle with our registrations for St. John Paul III! Thanks to the Registration Team led by Teri O'Connor, we are finally accomplishing this important aspect of the unification of our community, and establishment of our new parish.



For people of the Philippines and Mexico, registration is not a common practice in Catholic Churches. Perhaps because it is presumed that you are Catholic if you come from these countries, and so mostly the baptismal registry is the basis of one's membership in a parish. Here in the United States, registration has become a practice, in order to know the families who are supporting a specific national church. Back when there were up to five churches in one neighborhood, and people went to one of these churches according to their national identities, it was important to know who was part of your parish community. It helped alleviate confusion among the people, and helped them feel a sense of belongingness to their specific roots. That was the reality of America being a nation of immigrants; the Catholic Churches then were also churches of immigrants.

But today, why do we register? Is it important?

Registration helps the parish in many ways, but it also helps the individual registered families. First of all, registration allows the parish to **identify the people that it serves**, to understand their demographics, to address their needs, to have an idea about **putting up ministries** to serve specific packets of the population of parishioners. Hispanic Ministry, for example, is formed out of the considerable number of Hispanic families registering in a parish. It is also **helpful for taxation purposes**, because parishioners whose contribute financially to the mission of the church may receive a tax break out of such contributions. It is possible for us to make a **clear accounting of parishioners' contributions** if there is a clear registration list. Another important reason is **record keeping**, because when families are registered here, we also get to make a better system of keeping sacramental records, that is baptisms, first communions, weddings, and the life. When parishioners need such documents, and there are many Catholic parishes in their area, they would know where to go to ask for those documents. Also, in our civic life, we may be asked about our church affiliations, **for purposes of documentations, immigration, schooling, and other situations when we are asked to provide legal and verifiable historical ties to the community**, when we are registered at a specific parish, we are able to request such documentations. And perhaps most importantly, registering to a parish **fosters our sense of belongingness and commitment**. It is so easy to be lost in a large or growing community, and so registration helps us feel connected, and responsible for a specific Catholic community. It helps us **participate in the life of the Church** in our local area, by volunteering and keeping **regular contact with fellow parishioners**. And practically, by registering to a specific parish, that parish community becomes responsible for your spiritual wellbeing, sacramental needs and even human needs. By virtue of your registration, the pastor is canonically bound to help you grow in your spiritual life, administer sacraments, offer resources available for your human needs, and even assure you of a proper rite of Christian burial!

As your pastor, registration is really simply the art of building community, of calling people to participate in the life of the Church. For me, it is a systematic way of building the family of faith. It is a gesture that says, "We are pilgrims in this journey, and we are here to help each other." So, my dear Church, let's get to it, and register to St. John Paul II Parish!

REGISTRACIÓN PARROQUIAL Y EL ARTE DE EDIFICAR UNA COMUNIDAD DE FE

Ya estamos tomando registraciones para San Juan Pablo III! Gracias al Equipo de Registración dirigido por Teri O'Connor, que finalmente estamos para efectuar la unificación de nuestra comunidad, y así establecer nuestra nueva parroquia.

Para la gente de las Filipinas y México, el registrarse en las Iglesias Católicas no es necesario. Quizá porque se supone que todos son Católicos procedentes de estos países, y además el registro bautismal es la base a la membresía en la parroquia. Aquí en Estados Unidos, el registrarse es la práctica, para así conocer las familias que sostienen a una específica iglesia en la nación. En tiempos pasados cuando había cinco iglesias en la vecindad, y la gente iba según su identidad nacional, era importante saber quién era parte de la comunidad parroquial. Ayudaba en evitar confusión entre la gente, y les ayudaba en tener un sentido de pertenencia a su específica raíz étnica. Esa era la realidad en América al ser inmigrantes de alguna nación; las Iglesias Católicas en aquel entonces eran iglesias de inmigrantes.

Pero, hoy día, ¿porqué nos registramos? ¿Es importante?

La registración ayuda a la parroquia en muchas maneras, pero también ayuda a las familias individuales. Primeramente, el registro permite a la parroquia en **identificar a la gente necesitada**, en comprender sus demográficas, en atender a sus necesidades, en tener cierta idea para **crear ministerios apropiados** para la población de feligreses. Por ejemplo el ministerio a los Hispanos, se formula según el número de familias registradas en la parroquia. También **ayuda tocante los taxes**, porque los feligreses que contribuyen financieramente a la misión de la iglesia pueden recibir compensación del gobierno. Para nosotros, se facilita llevar un **informe claro de las contribuciones de los feligreses** cuando tenemos una lista clara de registración. Otra razón importante es **guardar registros**, porque cuando las familias estan registradas aquí, entonces llevamos un buen sistema de guardar el registro de los sacramentos, de bautismo, primera comunión, matrimonio, y la vida. Cuando feligreses necesitan algunos documentos, ellos saben a dónde dirigirse para obtener esos documentos. También en nuestra vida civil, nos pueden interrogar sobre nuestra afiliación a alguna iglesia, **por motivos de documentación, educación, y otras situaciones cuando se nos pide presentar legalmente nuestro lazo histórico que verifica nuestra afiliación a la comunidad**, cuando estamos registrados a una parroquia específica, entonces podemos obtener tales documentos. Y quizá de suma importancia, registrándonos a una parroquia **fomenta un sentido de pertenencia y compromiso**. Es muy fácil perderse en una comunidad grande que va aumentando, y por eso, el registro nos ayuda a sentirnos conectados, y responsables a una específica comunidad Católica. Nos ayuda a **participar en la vida de la Iglesia** en nuestra área local, por medio de servicio voluntario y el **estar en contacto regularmente con amigos feligreses**. Y prácticamente, al registrarse en una parroquia específica, esa comunidad asume la responsabilidad de su bienestar espiritual, sus necesidades sacramentales y hasta sus necesidades temporales. En virtud de su registración, su pastor está canónicamente obligado en ayudarlo a crecer en su vida espiritual, administrar los sacramentos, ofrecer medios disponibles para sus necesidades temporales, y hasta asegurarle en un rito apropiado para un entierro Cristiano!

Como su pastor, la registración es simplemente el arte en formar comunidad, en llamar a la gente a participar en la vida eclesial. Para mí, es una manera sistemática para formar una familia de fe. Es un gesto que dice, "Nosotros somos peregrinos en esta jornada, y estamos aquí para ayudarnos unos a otros." Entonces, mi querida Iglesia, ¡adelante, en registrarse en la Parroquia San Juan Pablo III!

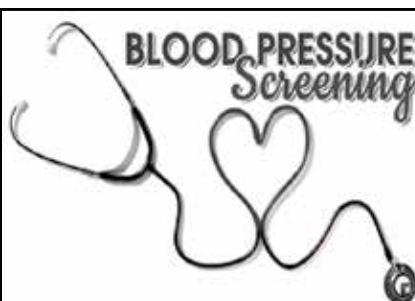

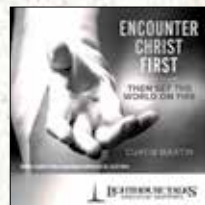
