

OUR DAILY MASS SPIRITUAL POWERHOUSE!

We are blessed to have many people coming to our daily morning masses! Making it a spiritual habit to go to church during the week, when it is not required, gives a lot of spiritual benefits.

Beginning the day in prayer, liturgy, receiving the Eucharist, and offering thanks to God, is a very positive thing. When this develops into a habit, one can see the effects in one's disposition, and also how such disposition can affect other things that happen throughout the day. Beginning with a holy mass, receiving the sacrament and thanking God for the new day is just a perfect way to begin the day, and it is a positive way to jumpstart everything the right way. This specific spiritual rhythm is definitely the best morning ritual ever.

There is a certain type of discipline that is developed by regularly attending morning mass, or daily mass. Getting up early, I am generally challenged, because of later sleep time. But daily mass gives me a sense of immediate purpose in the morning, which I could otherwise spend lazily moving in circles around the house. When I don't get to go to mass sometimes, I end up wasting the early morning dragging myself to start the day, so I'd rather perk up quickly for mass, and get going with my tasks, making me feel more productive and accomplished at the end of the day.

As your pastor, I want to say thank you to our "morning mass community", a group of people in our parish who pray for the rest of us every morning. I am privileged to celebrate morning mass with this super elite group of intercessors for the entire family of faith. Their dedication is humbling, and their devotion is inspiring. Although our masses generally last about thirty minutes, with a short homily and less singing, it is a full mass with full spiritual benefits. St. Peter Julian Eymard once said, "Every Holy Mass, heard with devotion, produces in our souls marvelous effects, abundant spiritual and material graces which we ourselves, do not know."

In many ways, our morning mass group is also becoming more and more a small Christian community, and as we are becoming more and more connected in our new parish, these morning mass friends are also becoming more and more familiar with one another, and growing socially as well. I am hoping that we will be able to start a breakfast-after-mass once a month, soon.

Another benefit that I find about daily mass is having the opportunity to learn about the saints, whose feasts are usually celebrated during the week. Last Wednesday, for example, we celebrated the feast of Saint Rose of Lima, and so I told the church about her story, her beauty, her penance, and her beautiful soul. We learn so much about the saints during these feast days, and their stories are so inspiring.

I hope that underneath this bulletin article, you are hearing a gentle invitation to consider coming to morning mass, during the week. This is one good way in participating in the spiritual life of our parish, by being part of the spiritual powerhouse of daily mass attendees!

Somos bendecidos cuando vemos a mucha gente en las misas cotidianas! Haciendo esto un hábito espiritual al ir a la iglesia durante la semana, cuando no es obligatorio, esto nos concede muchos beneficios espirituales.

Comenzando el día con oración, liturgia, recibiendo la Eucaristía, y ofreciendo gracias a Dios, es algo muy positivo. Cuando esto llega a ser hábito, uno puede ver los efectos en la disposición personal, y también cómo esa disposición puede afectar otras cosas que suceden durante el día. Comenzando con la santa misa, recibiendo el sacramento y dando gracias a Dios por el nuevo día es una manera perfecta al comenzar el día, y es una manera positiva en emprender todas las cosas debidamente. Este específico ritmo espiritual es definitivamente el mejor rito matutino para siempre.

Hay un cierto tipo de disciplina que se desarrolla por medio de la regularidad en atender la misa por la mañana o la misa diaria. El levantarme temprano, generalmente es un reto, porque me gustaría levantarme mas tarde. Pero la misa temprano y diaria me da un sentido de propósito inmediato, que de otra manera, pasaría el día moviéndome en círculos perezosos alrededor de la casa. Cuando algunas veces no logro ir a misa entonces siento perder la mañana con pesadez en comenzar el día, así es que prefiero madrugar y pronto ir a misa, y después seguir con mis tareas, eso me hace sentir mas productivo y mas cumplido al terminar el día.

Como su pastor, doy las gracias a 'mi comunidad de misa matutina', un grupo de feligreses matutinos que oran diariamente por el resto de la comunidad. Es un privilegio para mí celebrar la misa matutina con un grupo especial que intercede por toda la familia de fe. Su dedicación es modesta, y su devoción inspiradora. Nuestras misas generalmente duran unos treinta minutos, con una corta homilía y menos cantos, es en sí una misa entera con máximos beneficios espirituales. San Pedro Julián Eymard una vez dijo, "Toda Misa Santa, atendida con devoción, produce efectos maravillosos en nuestras almas, una abundancia de gracias espirituales y materiales que nosotros mismos no llegamos a conocer."

En muchas maneras, nuestro grupo de misa matutina cada vez mas viene a ser una pequeña comunidad Cristiana, y según mas y mas logramos ser conectados en nuestra nueva parroquia, estos amigos de misa matutina van logrando formar familia el uno con el otro, y al mismo tiempo van creciendo socialmente. Espero que pronto logremos comenzar mensualmente un desayuno al mes después de la misa.

Otro beneficio que descubro sobre la misa diaria es el tener la oportunidad de conocer a los santos, cuyas fiestas celebramos durante la semana. Por ejemplo, el miércoles pasado, celebramos la fiesta de Santa Rosa de Lima, y conté su historia a la iglesia, su belleza, su penitencia, y su maravilloso espíritu. Aprendemos mucho acerca de los santos en sus días de fiesta, y sus historias son muy inspiradoras.

Espero que este artículo lleve consigo, una amable invitación que llegue a sus oídos, en considerar venir a la misa matutina durante la semana. Esta es una buena manera de participar en la vida espiritual de nuestra parroquia, y ser parte de la ¡central eléctrica espiritual de los que participan en las misas diarias!
