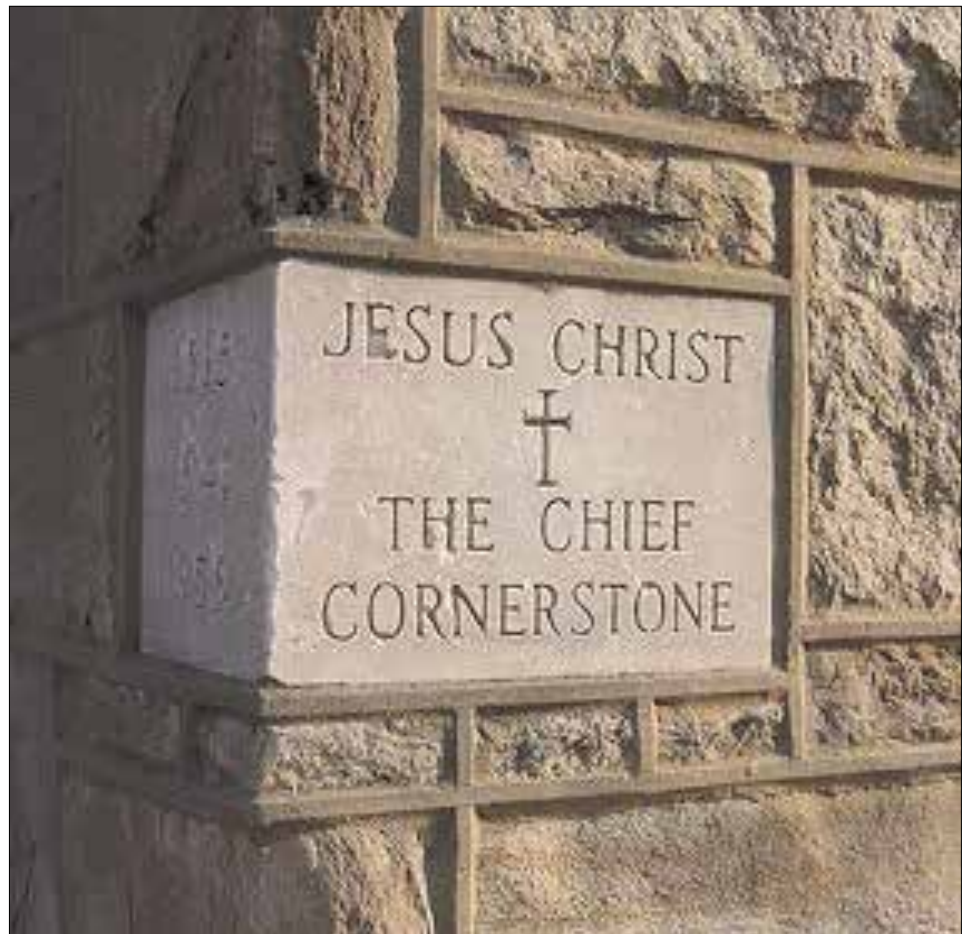

CALLING FOR A CULTURE POSITIVITY



LLAMAMIENTO A UNA CULTURA POSITIVA

It has been three months and two weeks since we launched Saint John Paul II Parish, and while it is true that we have accomplished many things as a community in such a short time, and we have just finished a very successful Ministry Fair and Open House two weeks ago, it is important for me to offer some reminders for all of us about the change of culture that we all need to be aware of and intentional about. These kinds of messages, I feel are helpful reminders. I put on my "father hat" to address challenging situations and offer a fatherly reminder to us all, for the sake of our spiritual family.

CHOOSING GOOD WILL. I want to re-iterate that good will is an absolute necessity if we want to succeed as a parish, and our true enemies are the attitudes of suspicion. When a decision was made two weeks ago to address the bat issues at Saint Rose Church, someone suspected that it was somehow planned, based on the coincidence that it was also the weekend of the Open House, as if someone is intentionally doing something bad, just to promote our parish event. That way of thinking is completely contrary to the culture of good will that we are developing in our parish. Here at JP2, we begin by always believing that our people are good, and to suspect the integrity of our leaders is just simply not a godly thing to do. Saint Bonaventure warned his community during his time about the evil of suspicion and promoted good will for the reform of his people. We need to do the same today.

BREAKING DOWN THE LANGUAGE OF SEPARATION. We need to continue to think of our oneness as a parish, instead of the distinction of the three parishes that we have come from. In a group conversation about procedures at mass, one parishioner said, "That's how you do it, but this is how we do it here..." But since becoming John Paul II, we have to keep in mind that it doesn't matter much anymore what individual parishes used to do, because we have to look at the bigger picture now, with the presumed larger parish community, and integration of all that we are doing. What was done anywhere by anyone before may not work with our new parish, and the language of separation (yours vs. ours) does not conform with the spirit of our unity as a new Church family. I heard another parishioner once say in casual conversation, "They are doing their party outdoors!" It was of course a reference to Hispanic Kermes / Fiesta a few weeks ago. It is another example of separationist language, where people think that the events of our Hispanic community are not in any way relevant to all of us. If we are one community, we need to celebrate one another, and not separate ourselves into various exclusive ethnic events. Here in Jp2, we are one, in the midst of our diversity, and we embrace all differences as a strength and asset of our community.

DIMINISHING NEGATIVE MENTALITY. As we continue to evangelize, invite the young people and the young adults into our parish, I ask that we put on a good attitude, smile more and spend more time looking at the good things that are happening instead of dwelling on complaints and negativity. It's really up to us to choose to be happy, and really, if we look enough, we will find many reasons to be happy individually and as a community. There are legitimate concerns that we need to address, but for the most part, a lot of our complaining is rooted in selfishness. Let's together as a family look at the plight of many people around us who have some real reasons to vent and complain. But for most of us, I believe that we can muster still a good attitude and a positive mind, despite what we are tempted to grouch about.

Always remember, God is good! And grace is all around us...

Ya hace tres meses y dos semanas desde que lanzamos la Parroquia San Juan Pablo II, y aunque es realidad que hemos efectuado muchas cosas como comunidad en corto tiempo, y apenas hemos realizado el gran evento La Feria de Ministerios y Casa Abierta hace dos semanas, es importante para mí ofrecer algunos recordatorios para todos nosotros acerca del cambio de cultura que todos necesitamos en estar al tanto de vivir intencionalmente. Este tipo de mensajes, yo creo que son recordatorios saludables. Me pongo mi "sombrero de padre" para dirigirme a estas situaciones de grandes desafíos y ofrecer recordatorios a todos nosotros, para la consideración de nuestra familia espiritual.

ESCOGIENDO LA BUENA VOLUNTAD. Quiero repetir que la buena voluntad es una necesidad absoluta si es que deseamos tener buen éxito como parroquia, y nuestros verdaderos enemigos son las actitudes y sospechas. Cuando se hizo la decisión hace dos semanas en publicar el problema de los murciélagos en la Iglesia Santa Rosa, alguien sospechaba que quizá era algo planeado, basado en la coincidencia que era el fin de semana de la Casa Abierta, como si fuera algo que se hacía con mala intención, para así promover nuestro evento parroquial. Esta manera de pensar es completamente contraria a la cultura de buena voluntad que estamos desarrollando en nuestra parroquia. Aquí en JP2, comenzamos con la creencia que nuestra gente es buena, y el sospechar la integridad de nuestros líderes es simplemente el no participar en la obra de Dios. San Buenaventura advertía a su comunidad durante su vida sobre el mal de la sospecha y promovía la buena voluntad para la reforma de su gente. Necesitamos hacer eso mismo hoy día.

AGOTANDO EL LENGUAJE DE LA SEPARACIÓN. Necesitamos pensar continuamente en nuestra unidad como parroquia, en lugar de la distinción de las tres parroquias de donde procedemos. En una conversación en grupo tocante los procedimientos en la misa, un parroquiano dijo, "Eso es lo que ustedes hacen, pero esto es lo que hacemos aquí..." Pero desde que somos Juan Pablo II, debemos tener presente que ya no se considera lo que hacían las parroquias individuales, porque debemos considerar el panorama mas amplio en la actualidad, y con la integración en todo lo que estamos haciendo. Lo que hacíamos antes en otros lugares por cualquier persona ya no se puede aplicar a nuestra nueva parroquia, y el lenguaje de separación (tuyo versus lo nuestro) no efectúa conformidad con el espíritu de nuestra unidad como nueva familia Eclesial. En una conversación, un parroquiano dijo, "Ellos están haciendo su fiesta afuera!" Esto fue en referencia a la Kermes Hispana hace unas semanas. Este es otro ejemplo de lenguaje separatista, cuando la gente piensa que los eventos de nuestra comunidad Hispana no son pertinentes a todos nosotros. Si somos una comunidad, entonces necesitamos celebrarnos unos a otros, y no separarnos en varios eventos étnicos exclusivos. Aquí en JP2, somos uno, en medio de nuestra diversidad, y abrazamos todas las diferencias como fuerza y recurso de nuestra comunidad.

DISMINUYENDO LA MENTALIDAD NEGATIVA. Según vamos evangelizando, invitemos a los jóvenes y a los jóvenes adultos a nuestra parroquia, y les pido adoptar una buena actitud, sonreír mas y gastar mas tiempo en ver las cosas buenas que están pasando en lugar de pensar en quejas y negatividad. En realidad depende de nosotros escoger el ser feliz, y en realidad, si vemos mas a fondo, veremos que hay muchas razones para ser felices individualmente y como comunidad. Hay preocupaciones legítimas que merecen nuestra atención, pero por lo general, la mayoría de las quejas tienen su raíz en el egoísmo. Como familia, hay que ver la condición de mucha gente a nuestro alrededor que tienen razón en dar a saber sus quejas. Pero la mayoría de nosotros, yo creo que podemos demostrar una buena actitud y una mente positiva, aún cuando hay la tentación de quejarnos.

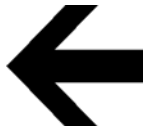
