## LENTEN SPIRITUALITY AND THE HONESTY OF CHRISTIAN REFLECTION



## ESPIRITUALIDAD CUARESMA Y LA HONESTIDAD DE REFLEXION CRISTIANA

Back in the Philippines, I once did a personal guided retreat where part of my daily routine was to look at myself in the mirror for at least thirty minutes. Talk about reflection, in the literal sense. At first, I thought it was a bit silly, since I am used to looking at myself in the mirror, and I have come from a background where looking at one's face in the mirror was an important part of one's investment, especially when public exposure meant every acne or blemish was a big deal. But this exercise was different. Something happened to me as I continued doing the routine of quietly and prayerfully looking at my reflection on a mirror. At a certain point, I was no longer just looking at hair, eyes, cheek, or any part of my face; suddenly, I was looking at my SELF, who I am, this being in front of the mirror. As I stared at myself, I began to experience a sense of detachment and awe at the mystery of my own existence, and perhaps, even more importantly, I began to think about this person that was reflected in the mirror and what he has been all these years.

Lent is a special time when we go in front of a spiritual mirror to see ourselves more clearly. Of course, I am not talking about the physical vision, but to go deeper into ourselves and see our brokenness with greater honesty and devotion.

It takes a great deal of discipline and intentionality to observe the devotions of lent. Monitoring ourselves to make sure that we don't eat the chocolate that we promised to give up in the season can be hard enough, but to enter into a spiritual journey of self-reflection and spiritual discipline of charity and prayer, can be daunting to those who have not developed such habits. But that's lent. It is a good season because it somehow forces us to pay more attention to such things about ourselves, instead of just going through days of mechanical, unexamined life. Lent is an opportunity to finally seek deeper meanings in our lives.

May we all together take to heart the opportunity for self-reflection that this season brings, for our individual good, and for the good of the entire Body of Christ, the Church, of which we are all a part. BLESSED LENT!
