AN OPEN LETTER TO FATHER JESUS

Father Jesús.... Father Jesús.... What a wonderful sound to the ears!!! Father Jesús, congratulations for making that leap of faith into the priesthood! It must have felt like you were in a football stadium where everyone was rooting for you but you have to be the one to make the goal. As you kick to the goal, allow me to be your coach one final time, and offer you some to-go encouragements, as you run to the new playing fields of your priestly life.

Be yourself, use your voice. God is not asking you to be anyone but yourself. You have unique experiences and unique gifts that are only yours to use. As you prostrated before God at the cathedral on your ordination, let that spirit of total self-giving help you to make yourself available for God, every moment of every day. There is only one Fr. Jesus Oliveros in all human history, and you will realize that God has called you to be a priest for equally unique and specific purposes. Be yourself, use your voice, and enjoy the discovery of God's specific purposes for you.

Don't forget to pray. You are ordained to be a man of prayer. This is at the heart of everything that happens in your life as a priest, yet it always seems to be the easiest to forego. Once your prayer gets compromised, you start to lose focus on why you are ordained in the first place. That is why, whatever happens, be constant in your prayer. Even for only two minutes, take a pause chime in with the divine conversation. Keep listening to God's voice even in the middle of a busy moment of ministry. God is always there.

Balance your life. This is a lifelong struggle for every priest because the expectation laid upon our shoulders is not always realistic. But just try your best. Take time to rest, to eat well, to engage in recreation and enjoy some hobbies. Stay connected with your friends and family. Go to the movies. Visit home back in Puerto Vallarta. Your life as a priest is not defined only by your moments of active ministry, but by the totality of your wellbeing that serves the Church. This is the only way that you can be a healthy priest.

Remember that you are not doing this alone. Not only are you guided by the Holy Spirit whose power you received as the Bishop laid hands on you. You are not alone because you have a full community of saints who are praying for you. Know that you are not alone because you have your brother priests to be your support system, and I know that you have your St. John Paul II family for the rest of your priesthood. You will always have a home in Kankakee, especially because I know that people here care about you, welcome you and love you as their own.

Finally, know that you have a brother priest for life in me. I have great respect and admiration for your personal qualities as a human being, which will be helpful in your priesthood. You came here assigned to me as a Deacon Intern, and soon you will leave Kankakee as my friend and brother priest. Amazing! It has been a pleasure to get to know you, to get to truly be open with someone who shares some similar experiences of being uprooted from our home country to serve God's people here in the USA. I, together with the entire parish family of St. John Paul II, am very proud of you. Thank you for allowing us to be part of your story. Ad multos annos!

Solo de esta manera puedes ser un sacerdote sano.

Recuerda que no estas sólo en esto. No sólo estas guiado por el Espíritu Santo cuyo poder has recibido cuando el Obispo te impuso sus manos. No estas sólo porque tienes una gran comunidad de santos rezando por tí. Reconoce que no estas sólo porque cuentas con tus hermanos sacerdotes que te apoyan, y sé que tu familia de San Juan Pablo II te apoya en tu vida sacerdotal. Siempre tendrás un hogar en Kankakee, especialmente porque la gente aquí te aprecia bastante, te da la bienvenida y te ama cómo si fueras parte de su familia.

Finalmente, quiero hacerte saber que tienes en mí un hermano sacerdote para el resto de tu vida. 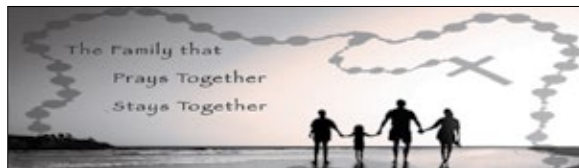
