CONCLUSIONS AND BEGINNINGS

As a priest, I am exposed in a unique way to these things, as I celebrate birth and rebirth with young families, or being by the bedside of someone who is closing the final chapter of life or join a grieving crowd in homage to a person who has passed.

Life is indeed full of little deaths. That is why at the end of the day, the church prays these beautiful and solemn words of dying: Lord, now you let your servant go in peace. Your word has been fulfilled. My own eyes have seen the salvation which you have prepared in the sight of your people, and the glory of your people Israel. This breviary prayer at night is lifted from the prayer of Simeon calling out to the Lord for his final chapter, as he saw the child Jesus presented in the temple. He surrenders his life to the Lord and gives Him glory for all that has been and for the fulfillment of His promise! And just as Simeon has surrendered to the plan of the Lord, we the Christians of today, are still being called to the same attitude of grateful surrender to God's plan.

As we come to the final weeks of this fiscal year, I ask you, my dear St. John Paul II family, to take a pause, and think of all the things that happened here in Kankakee during the past couple of years. Try to look at it from the point of view of a higher plan. Try to name the moments of ending, as well as the moments of beginning. Try to name the graces and blessings that came along the way, but also the sacrifices that had to be borne. Now, say a prayer with me: *Lord God, our Beginning and End, thank you for the great plan you authored for all creation. Thank you for making us participate in this story, unfolding in such a marvelous way. Thank you that you are our God, and we, through the beginnings and conclusions of life, remain steadfast in your everlasting love. Amen.*

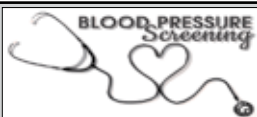
