PENSAMIENTOS DE REGRESO A CLASE

As I hear, our children have all begun the school year, and everyone is pretty much in full swing at this point. During this time of the year, I also hear many parents expressing their anxiety about their children leaving home and going to college, especially those who are having this experience for the first time. It can be very emotional indeed, and equally nostalgic. Even as an uncle to my nephews, I sometimes just sigh in amazement thinking how quickly time has flown that the little boys that I used to take to Chuckie Cheese are now grown-ups, one with a full-time job with an airline company, one in college, and one finishing high school.

The young ones going back to school usually have a sense of excitement but also some level of anxiety about what the new school year would bring. They are anxious about their new teachers, the challenging subjects that they need to at least pass, and the new friends and peers that they will meet. My prayer for our children is that they will find every opportunity to grow not only in knowledge, but even more importantly, in their appreciation of their worth as human beings. Our children need to have a consistently positive message of self-respect and self-empowerment. They need to have the confidence to set goals for their lives, not to settle for mediocrity nor simply being OK. They need to be encouraged to aim for personal excellence in all facets of their lives. This is my prayer for our children – to be the best that they can be, through the help of their family, the community, the church and their schools and peers!

My prayer for all the parents is that they may never tire in providing a healthy environment for their children. Parenting is never easy, but a lot of the investment in the lives of these children is really about simply being there for them, being able to have some quality family time, and have a mutually respectful relationship. There are so many things that distract our homes these days, including social media, our “created needs” and our real needs, various extra-curricular activities that take so much time yet produce very little in the formation of the young into well-rounded individuals. My hope and prayer is that parents become wiser in deciding how to really support the dreams and needs of their children, and most importantly, to take seriously their role in raising their children in loving God and others.

Here at St. John Paul II Parish, we constantly endeavor to provide a healthy and safe environment for the children and the young. Beginning from the clergy and religious, to the staff and parish leaders, all the way down to the individual families and volunteers that are part of our parish family, we are always looking for ways to create an holy, happy and healthy environment where they can grow to be the people that God has dreamed for them, when they were conceived in the womb.

May God continue to bless our schools, the teachers and faculty, as well as the students, in this new school year. May God bless our Church, that our children may encounter the Lord in a profound way, through us.
