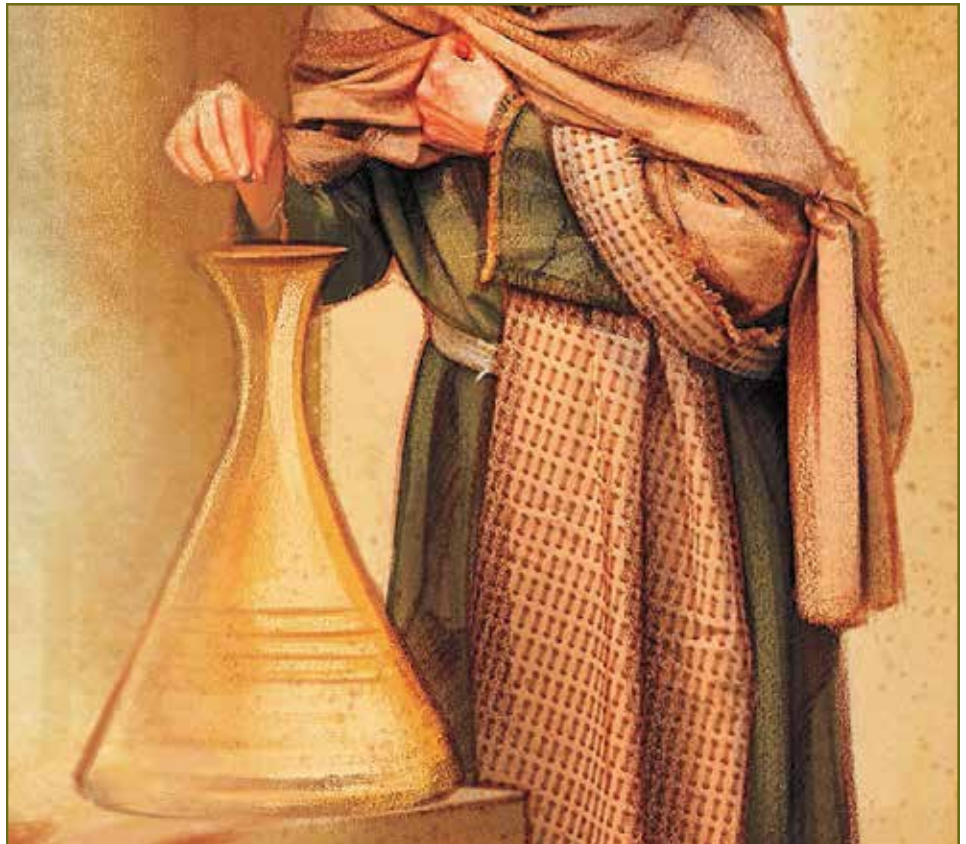

THE PASTOR FACTOR:

Welcome back home, Fr. Tony Taschetta!

This weekend, our parish is privileged to have with us one of my mentors – Fr. Tony Taschetta. Who in Kankakee might not know or at least may have not heard of Fr. Tony? He practically spent the best of his priestly years in this city, where for twelve years, he served as pastor of the former St. Teresa Church on the east side of town. Beyond his work there as a pastor, he was very exposed in this community. For me, Fr. Tony demonstrates that the pastor is indeed an important factor in the wellbeing of a parish community, in the same sense that our parishioners' stewardship is a key to our continued success.

When I was a transitional deacon, I was assigned to work on the weekends at my own parish of St. Isidore in Bloomington, where Fr. Tony was assigned pastor. As a deacon, I watched how he dealt with people, his passion for connection, and his amazing homilies that would grab your attention as soon as the first word was spoken. I watched him thoroughly and enthusiastically explain the relevance of the anointing of chrism at baptism, something that I still try to do myself now. I watched him manage a parish and successfully pay off diocesan debts. I knew I was in the midst of a great role model just by watching how he did things as a pastor. But when I came to Kankakee seven years ago, I was even made more aware of the amazing gift that he is to the diocese, to our community in Kankakee, and to the priesthood in general. When St. Teresa Parish had the vision to welcome the Hispanic families of Kankakee to that church, Fr. Tony was moved from Hopkins Park to Kankakee to make that happen. His leadership paved the way to establishing a full blown Hispanic Ministry in that parish, and looked to the future of that ministry by setting up funds and scholarships so that the Hispanic children would be able to attend Catholic grade school. He collaborated with the late Helen Chigaros in order to put up a clinic to offer health services to those who were uninsured. He taught people to be welcoming, to be passionate about their faith, to be involved, to sing, to laugh and to be a joyful family of faith. And today, even as St. John Paul II, we are reaping the fruits of the seeds that were planted during his time here in Kankakee. And so, I am compelled to just acknowledge the fact that we are grateful to God for the gift of his priesthood.

Welcome back home to Kankakee, Fr. Tony. May your time here in Kankakee be full of joy, and we hope for many more opportunities to be together again, especially in being together in the table of the Lord.

EL FACTOR DEL SACERDOTE

Bienvenido a su casa, Padre Tony Taschetta!

Este fin de semana, es un privilegio para nuestra parroquia tener con nosotros, a uno de mis guías – Padre Tony Taschetta. Quien no conoce o no ha oído del Padre Tony? Él pasó la mayor parte de su sacerdocio en esta ciudad, donde por doce años él fue pastor de la Iglesia Sta. Teresa situada al este del pueblo. Además de su trabajo como pastor, él estaba muy expuesto a toda la comunidad. Para mí, el Padre Tony demuestra que el pastor es en realidad un factor importante para el bienestar de la comunidad parroquial, en el mismo sentido que nuestros feligreses son responsables de nuestro continuo éxito parroquial.

Quando yo era diácono transicional, yo fui asignado a trabajar los fines de semana en mi propia parroquia de San Isidoro en Bloomington, donde el Padre Tony era asignado pastor. Como diácono, yo observaba como él trataba a la gente, su pasión en relaciones humanas, y sus estupendas homilias que aclamaban la atención inmediata de todos los oyentes. Yo veía como él detalladamente y con gran entusiasmo explicaba acerca de la unción del crisma en el bautizo, algo que todavía trato de hacer hoy día. Yo lo observaba como manejaba la parroquia y admirablemente pagaba las deudas a la diócesis. Yo reconocía que estaba en presencia de un gran modelo pastor y observaba cómo hacía las cosas. Pero cuando llegué a Kankakee hace siete años, yo me daba cuenta del asombroso don personal que él era para la diócesis, para nuestra comunidad en Kankakee, y para el clero en general. Cuando la parroquia Sta. Teresa contemplaba dar la bienvenida a las familias hispanas de Kankakee, el Padre Tony se mudó de Hopkins Park a Kankakee para que esto se hiciera realidad. Su liderazgo preparó el camino para establecer un gran Ministerio Hispano en esa parroquia, y viendo hacia el futuro de ese ministerio, era el recaudar fondos y becas para que los niños hispanos pudieran atender la primaria en la escuela Católica. Él y Helen Chigaros (que en Dios descansen) establecieron una clínica médica para ofrecer servicios a los que no tienen a seguridad. Él enseñó a la gente a dar la bienvenida, a ser comprometidos, a cantar, a reír y formar una familia alegre de fe. Y hoy, que somos la parroquia San Juan Pablo II, estamos cosechando los frutos de las semillas que fueron plantadas durante su tiempo aquí en Kankakee. Así es que, me siento obligado en hacer saber que estamos muy agradecidos a Dios por el don de su sacerdocio.

Bienvenido nuevamente a su casa en Kankakee, Padre Tony. Que su estancia aquí en Kankakee sea llena de alegría, y esperamos tener muchas más oportunidades de reunirnos nuevamente, especialmente reunirnos en la mesa del Señor.

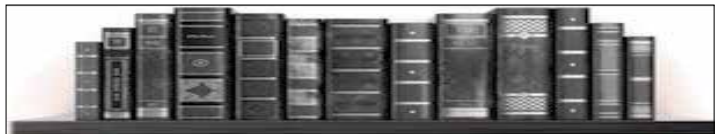


