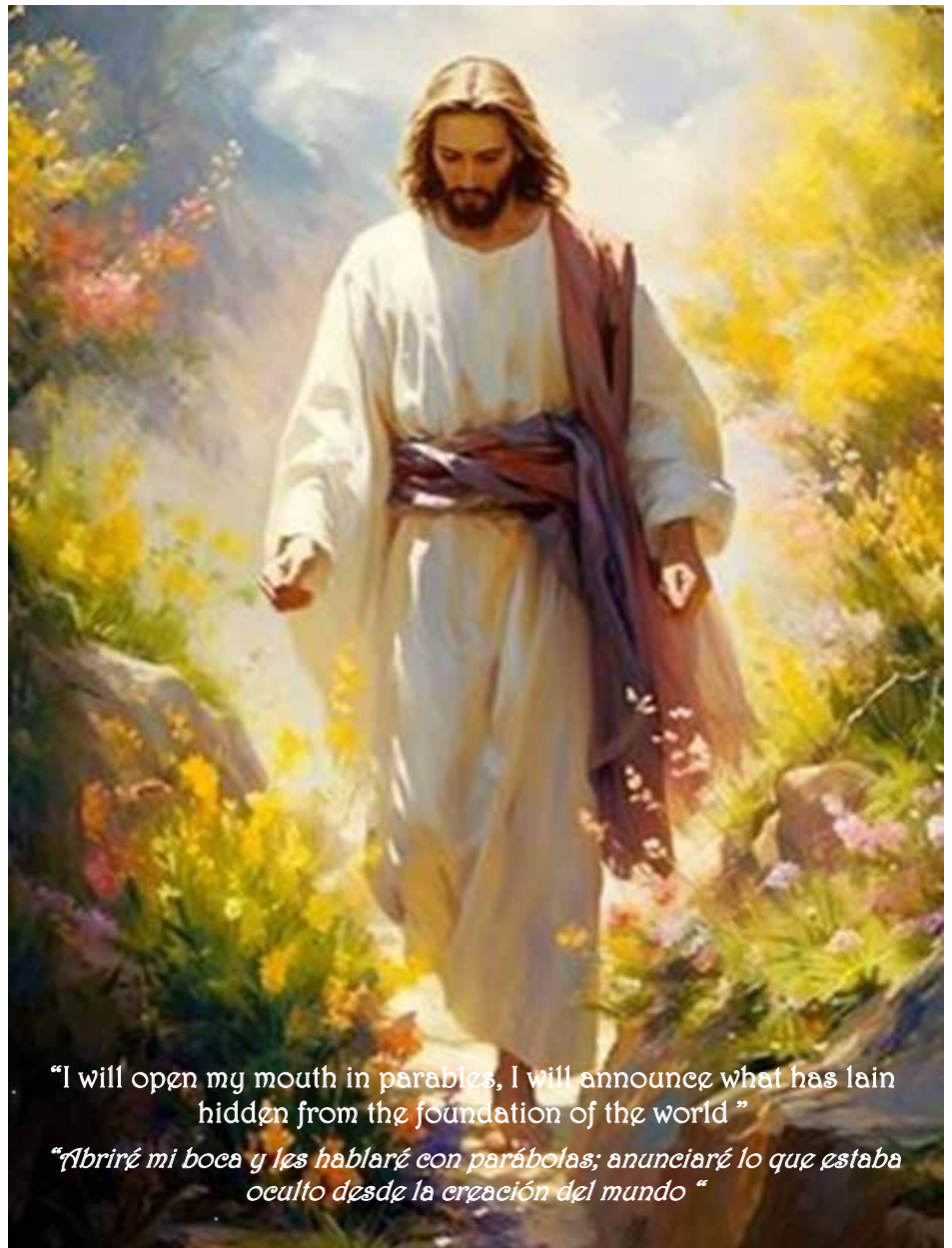

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

I have good news: The Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary Reparatrix are coming to Kankakee!

The Institute of the Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary Reparatrix- Ggogonya (IHMR) was founded in 1927 and was elevated to its current canonical status in 1948. Their motherhouse is in the Archdiocese of Kampala, Uganda, and today, there are 320 IHMR sisters serving in various dioceses in Uganda, Algeria, Germany, and the United States of America. The Diocese of Joliet is being added to that list with their anticipated arrival in the Kankakee area. They are initially sending two sisters: Sr. Maxensia Nyanzi and Sr. Susan Ninyikiriza. Sr. Maxensia will be the next director of our parish's Faith Formation Program, and Sr. Susan will be teaching at Bishop McNamara Catholic School. I do not have an exact date of their arrival since they are in the process of obtaining visas.

They will be residing at the convent at St. Joseph Parish in Bradley. Since the convent has been vacant for several years, it is in need of preparation, which is being accomplished in various phases:

- I. Removal of storage items and furniture
- II. Drywall, plumbing, and painting
- III. Cleaning
- IV. Carpets
- V. Furnishings and decorations

Phase I, as well as some drywall work and plumbing, have been completed, and now they are painting. We will be announcing when we need volunteers to clean. The CCWs of each parish are working together in coordinating the furnishings and housewares of the convent. They are looking for monetary donations. I encourage you to contribute next weekend using the special envelopes found in the back of church or electronically through our parish's online giving portal.

I am grateful for this opportunity. It has been providential and has happened very quickly. The week after I was informed of the decision of the Missionary Sisters of the Holy Family to decrease their number of convents in the U.S., resulting in the closing of the Kankakee convent, I was lamenting this news to another priest who had just heard that the IHMR sisters from Uganda were interested in establishing another community. When asked if I were interested, I said, "Of course!" After a series of meetings, conversations, tours, and prayer, we are happily receiving sisters from the Institute of the Immaculate Heart of Mary Reparatrix. I appreciate all of your support, especially your prayers that everything happens quickly and smoothly. Know of my prayers for you.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Tengo buenas noticias: ¡Las Hermanas del Inmaculado Corazón de María Reparadora vienen a Kankakee!

El Instituto de las Hermanas del Inmaculado Corazón de María Reparadora - Ggogonya (IHMR) fue fundado en 1927 y elevado a su estado canónico actual en 1948. Su casa madre está en la

Arquidiócesis de Kampala, Uganda, y hoy hay 320 hermanas IHMR sirviendo en varias diócesis en Uganda, Argelia, Alemania y los Estados Unidos. La Diócesis de Joliet se agrega a esa lista con su llegada anticipada al área de Kankakee. Inicialmente envían a dos hermanas: Hna. Maxensia Nyanzi y Hna. Susan Ninyikiriza. La Hna. Maxensia será la próxima directora del Programa de Formación en la Fe de nuestra parroquia y La Hna. Susan enseñará en la Escuela Católica Bishop McNamara. No tengo una fecha exacta de su llegada porque están en proceso de obtención de visas.

Residirán en el convento de la parroquia de San José en Bradley. Dado que el convento ha estado desocupado por varios años, necesita preparación, que se está realizando en varias fases:

- I. Retiro de elementos de almacenamiento y muebles
- II. Paneles de yeso, plomería y pintura
- III. Limpieza
- IV. Alfombras
- V. Mobiliario y decoración

Se completó la Fase I, así como algunos trabajos de plomería y paneles de yeso, y ahora están pintando. Vamos a anunciar cuando necesitemos voluntarios para limpiar. Los Concilios de Mujeres Católicas (CCW) de cada parroquia trabajan juntos en la coordinación de los muebles y artículos para el hogar del convento. Están buscando donaciones monetarias. Les animo a contribuir el próximo fin de semana utilizando los sobres especiales que se encuentran por la entrada de la iglesia o electrónicamente a través del portal de donaciones en línea de nuestra parroquia.

Estoy agradecido por esta oportunidad. Ha sido providencial y ha sucedido muy rápido. La semana después de que me informaron de la decisión de las Hermanas Misioneras de la Sagrada Familia de reducir su número de conventos en los Estados Unidos, lo que resultó en el cierre del convento de Kankakee, yo estaba lamentando esta noticia con otro sacerdote que acababa de escuchar que las Hermanas IHMR de Uganda estaban interesadas en establecer otra comunidad. Cuando me preguntó si yo estaba interesado, dije: "¡Por supuesto!". Después de una serie de encuentros, conversatorios, recorridos y oración, estamos recibiendo con alegría a las hermanas del Instituto del Inmaculado Corazón de María Reparadora. Agradezco todo su apoyo, especialmente sus oraciones para que todo suceda rápido y sin problemas. Conozcan mis oraciones por ustedes.

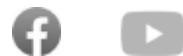
