

## THE AMFGY6 PROGRAM

(American Military Family Got Your six)

The AMF GY6 program is a "cutting edge" approach to the prevention of veterans/first responders suicide by implementing intrusive intervention for our heroes in crisis as well as providing wrap around services. Upon receipt of the urgent call or notification about a missing and/or suicidal veterans/first responders our team immediately puts "Boots on the Ground" with our Quick Reaction Force (QRF) team of Suicide Prevention Certified members in order to locate the person in a very timely fashion. We assess their current situation and attempt to locate the missing veteran/first responders by telephone or actual physical search. Once we have made physical contact we run a full assessment of their emotional, physical, and/or invisible wounds in an effort to determine how we can best serve their needs.

The AMF GY6 program addresses the seven (7) critical reintegration issues facing our Iraq/Afghanistan veterans:

- Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD)
- Traumatic Brain Injuries (TBI)
- Financial Stressors
- Earned veterans benefits/VA issues
- Societal/Personal Relationship Dissonance
- Job Reintegration
- Veteran Isolation/Self Medication

## PROBLEM TO SOLVE:

TO STOP THE EPIDEMIC OF VETERAN SUICIDE Every 65 minutes a veteran commits suicide. Suicide is never the solution, but the traumas of war have left devastating side effects. The invisible and physical wounds from Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) and Traumatic Brain Injuries (TBI) are debilitating. When combined with a litany of side effects from service to country, such as severe depression, suicidal ideation, sleep apnea, night terrors, relationship issues, self-medication, seclusion, legal and/or financial issues and hopelessness, it should serve as no surprise that the statistical data for number of suicides in the military and first responder community remains at an all-time high. For the past 18 years, American Military Family (AMF) has been answering the call by providing a reprieve from their many stresses as we address their physical, mental and emotional wounds, thereby providing them with the necessary services and resources they urgently need.
