He has worked through a number of Bible schools and has obtained an M.Min (Master of Ministry) in Christian leadership and a Th, D in Biblical studies and leadership. He is married to his one and only wife for forty-six (46) years, Deborah Anne Jones, and is the proud father of two children: DeAngela Y. Jones, a professional LPN, RN and Mark E. Jones II, a medical computer specialist. Bishop Mark E. Jones was born in Milwaukee Wisconsin.
