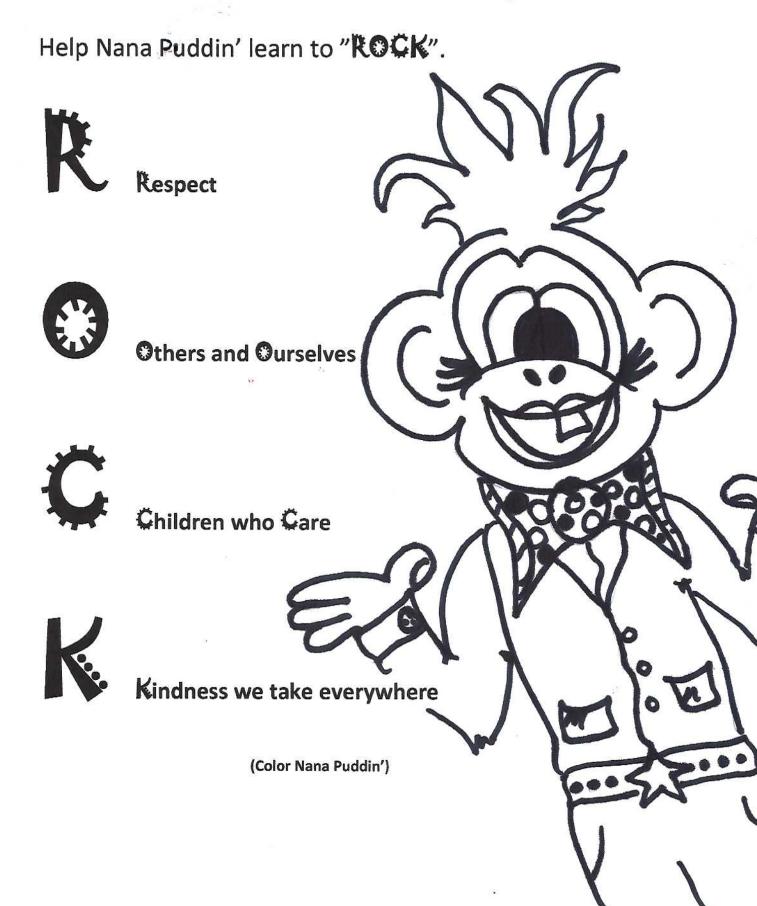
"Kindness Rocks" Day #1
