

OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT OF THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE GRANT VALLEY TOWN BOARD'S ANNUAL ROAD TOUR OF SATURDAY, MAY 5, 2018.

The Grant Valley Town Board of Supervisors met for their regularly scheduled annual Road Tour on Saturday, May 5, 2018, beginning at 8:00 a.m. at the Grant Valley Town Hall.

Board Members present were Hiltz, Moudry, and Clerk Schmidt. Also present was Wade Thoring from Thoring Grading.

Chairman Hiltz called the tour to order at 8:00 a.m.

FERN LAKE ROAD: Needs striping and crack sealing. East side of lake on corner needs some gravel and from Countryside Road going south needs about 4 loads of gravel.

KIMMER ROAD: Good.

DORIS COURT: O.k.

RED OAKS ADDITION: Good.

PINE CIRCLE COURT: O.k.

BUCHANAN: Needs gravel on North end.

COUNTRYSIDE ROAD: O.k.

LEONARDWAY RD: Tree needs to be taken down and some ruts on west side.

SPORTSMENS: Needs fill in one spot.

TROPHY BUCK AND LITTLE DOE: O.k.

MILLER ROAD: 2-3" lift of gravel needs to be put down.

RIVER CROSSING: Good.

RIVER HEIGHTS: Needs striping.

BELTRAMI LINE ROAD: Pretty good. Could use gravel in a couple of spots.

SUNSET MEADOWS: Good.

JADE DRIVE SW: Terrible road but not ours.

COUNTRY VIEW: Good.

DEER HAVEN CT SW: Good. Culvert by intersection needs to be dug out from the hump to the corner.

HIDDEN MEADOWS: Good.

TALL TIMBER LANE: Good.

STONE LAKE ROAD SW: Good. Supervisor Hiltz suggests this be the next road to get paved.

BOOT LAKE ROAD SW: Good.

BOOTLEG LAKE RD SW: Good.

HUCKLEBERRY: Good.

TWAIN DRIVE: Good.

DIVISION: Good.

WHISPERWOOD: Good.

BALSAM RIDGE SW: Needs gravel and the edges pulled in.

MISTY MEADOWS: Good.

BALSAM RIDGE NW: Good.

SHAMROCK COURT: Good.

LEPRECHAUN: Good.

BLARNEY CT: Good.

SIRIUS, POLLYX, PROCYON, CAPELLA: Need trees trimmed, otherwise good.

JUNEBERRY: Good.

GRANT LAKE LANE: Good. Intersection at Grantwood needs to be fixed.

GRANTWOOD: Good – garbage at end of cul-de-sac needs to be picked up.

MELBY LANE: Good.

STONE LAKE ROAD: Pretty good.

STACYRICH: Good.

BIRCH HILL: Little rough.

OLD WILLOW COURT: Rough, needs grading.

ARCHERY ROAD: Good.

PAUL MILLER LANE: Good.

MID-VALLEY LANE: Good.

ANNALEE LANE: Good.

QUIET POND TRAIL: O.k. Gate is up. We drove the road and it looks so much better than it used to. Marlys Eckman called and indicated they had been walking and picking up garbage and there was some dumped on the Archery Road. Litter is bad everywhere.

AVERI CIRCLE – Good. Needs a little gravel before tarring this year. Still waiting for feasibility study from Bob Seado.

SCHROEDER ROAD: Tree in ditch, otherwise Good.

SWEDMARK LANE: Need to fix hole by driveway at #196 and the holes by the intersection of Division but might wait until road work is going on as they might need to re-do that intersection anyway.

HIDDEN TRAIL: Needs crack sealing, otherwise good.

QUINCY, KENNEDY and ADAMS: Need crack sealing.

HUMMINGBIRD: Good.

JOHNSVILLE: Good.

GRANT VALLEY ROAD NW, BIG NORTH AND GROSBEAK: Need crack sealing.

BUTTERFLY AND COCOON: Good.

15th STREET: Needs crack sealing. Otherwise good.

CARMEN DRIVE: Good.

COUNTRY FIELD: Needs crack sealing and chunk of tar patched, otherwise good.

LITTLE FIELD: Needs crack sealing, otherwise good.

BOOT LAKE ROAD: Good.

GRANT HILLS ROAD SW: Needs to be shaped and some Class 5 put on the road.

Road Tour adjourned at 11:50 a.m. back at the town hall.
