THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

Exodus 20:3-17

INTRODUCTION:

1. People sometimes say, "Keep the 10 Commandments."
2. Many people living today have no concept of God's differing dispensations or laws.
3. **People are shocked to hear, "We're not under the law of Moses."**

DISCUSSION:

1. THE TEN COMMANDS INTRODUCED THE LAW OF MOSES.

1. Exodus 20:3-17.
2. Every time God gives a new law, it contains two basic aspects, duty to God and duty to man.
3. Jesus spoke of both in Matthew 22:37-39 — Love of God, and love of neighbor.

2. THE TEN COMMANDMENTS WERE A PART OF THE MOSAIC LAW.

1. Some have mistakenly thought the ten commandments were the WHOLE LAW OF MOSES.
2. The ten commandments functioned like the Bill of Rights in our land.
3. The Law of Moses was given only to the Jewish people (Deuteronomy 5:1-6).
4. This law was temporary, guiding Israel until the time when Christ would come, providing for obedient faith in Him (Galatians 3:23-25).

3. JESUS FULFILLED THE LAW (Matthew 5:17).

1. Jesus did not come to destroy the Law, but to fulfill it.
2. In fulfilling God's mission for him, Christ:
 1. Nailed the law to the cross (Colossians 2:14).
 2. Abolished the law in His flesh (Ephesians 2:15).
 3. After it was fulfilled, the law has been done away (Hebrews 10:9).

4. WHAT THE TEN COMMANDMENTS TAUGHT

1. No other "gods" (Exodus 20:3). This is still true today (Matthew 4:10).
2. No graven images (vs. 4-6). This is still true today (Acts 17:23).
3. Prohibited taking the Lord's name in vain (v. 7). Still true today (Matthew 6:9).
4. Remember the sabbath day (vs. 8-11). Christians are taught to worship God on the first day of the week (Acts 20:7 and 1 Corinthians 16:2).
5. Honor your father and mother (v. 12). Still true today (Ephesians 6:1-3).
6. Prohibited the taking of innocent life (v. 13). See 1 John 3:11-18).
7. Prohibited committing adultery (v. 14). See Matthew 19:3-13.
8. Prohibited stealing (v. 15). See Ephesians 4:28.
9. Prohibited bearing false witness (v. 16). See James 5:12.
10. Prohibited covetousness (v. 17). See 1 Corinthians 5:11.
