In the past year

-KCA successfully supported transparency and expansion of the Checkoff authority by allowing younger industry organizations to contract for Beef Checkoff funds.

-KCA successfully lobbied in the statehouse to preserve strong independent family agriculture operations.

-KCA formed coalitions and successfully lobbied to maintain ownership right over animals and prohibit animals from having the same rights as children.

-KCA successfully lobbied to strengthen the penalty for animal rights groups who violate Kansas law.
