65 FEET HIEGHT LORD SHIVA STATUE AT OLD AIRPORT ROAD, BENGALURU



1993-94: The Lord Shiva statue situated on the airport road in Bengaluru is a masterpirce made by Kashinath (Ms. Shreedevi's father). This statue is 65ft high and made in Dhyanamudhra style which looks pleasant and calm. The brigtness on Shiva's face makes anyone immerse with devotion. Lord Shiva is painted in bone white color and also a weather coat plastic emulsion is given. The yellow oxide and black mix color is given for in depth shade. Because of this shade the statue appears to be carved out of ivory marble. Around the statue, snow painted mountains have been made. For the people sitting around the status is a devotional spot.

1996: In Sri Venkateshwara temple of Kapu shilpi Kashinath constructed a beautiful mahadwara and mukhamantapa.
