This position will work in a cross functional role supporting the various other departments to ensure maximum uptime of the production facility through accurate and on time purchases meeting the programs requirements. Required Skills:

- Use of ERP / MRP systems (EPICOR knowledge is a +)
- Ability to understand technical requirements, and a willingness to ask when you don't know.
- Experience in a manufacturing environment
- Familiar with AS9100 / ISO 9001 requirements
- Ability to demonstrate organizational time management and decision-making skills
- Ability to manage oneself in an ever-changing priority atmosphere
- Strong Communication and Interpersonal skills
