ALEX PARKER

ALEX PARKER joined the faculty at Baylor in the Fall of 2001 and he is currently a Senior Lecturer and the Director of Jazz Studies. He serves as the director of the Baylor Jazz Ensemble, the Baylor Concert Jazz Ensemble, jazz combos, jazz string quartets and he teaches undergraduate and graduate students in several jazz disciplines.

Mr. Parker holds a Master of Music degree from the University of Miami at Coral Gables and a Bachelor of Music degree from the Eastman School of Music. His background is in jazz writing, jazz performance and jazz pedagogy, as well as trumpet performance and instrumental teaching.

Mr. Parker is a founding director of the Texas Jazz Educators Association and he now serves as a director on the executive board of the TJEA. He is also the past president of the Texas Chapter of the International Association for Jazz Education and he is a charter member of the Jazz Educators Network.

Mr. Parker has performed with the Eastman Jazz Ensembles, the Eastman Wind Ensemble and Philharmonia, as well as the Jazz, Salsa, and Wind Ensembles and combos at the University of Miami and many other professional ensembles and combos. His jazz and studio orchestra writing has been performed by many different groups around the country including the Harrisburg Symphony and ensembles at Eastman, Miami and at Baylor.

Mr. Parker is a sought after clinician and adjudicator. He has performed clinics, judged or worked with region and all state jazz ensembles all around Texas, Oklahoma and Costa Rica. He continues to teach trumpet privately and perform as a free-lance musician.

Bobby R. Francis is the Director of Bands at Texas Christian University. Mr. Francis serves as Conductor of the TCU Wind Symphony, teaches graduate and undergraduate conducting, and is responsible for the supervision of all aspects of the TCU Band program. Mr. Francis is an elected member of the American Bandmasters Association. He has served as guest conductor of the US Army Band – “The Pershing’s Own,” Frost School of Music – University of Miami Wind Symphony, The US Coast Guard Band, the Lone Star Youth Wind Orchestra and the Richardson All-Star Band. Mr. Francis’ ensembles have performed at many national, regional, and state conferences including a performance at the College Band Directors National Conference (CBDNA) in Ann Arbor, Michigan and in Athens, Georgia, the Texas Music Educators Association Convention in San Antonio, TX and at the American Bandmasters Association Convention in College Station, Texas. The TCU Wind Symphony has performed with guest artists such as the American Brass Quintet, Patrick Sheridan, Brian Bowman, Allen Vizzutti, Jon Lewis, Joe Eckert, Gary Whitman, Jesus Castro-Balbi and Markus Theinert. His ensembles have performed at Carnegie Hall in New York City, Morton H. Meyerson Symphony Center in Dallas, and the Bass Performance Hall in Fort Worth. Many composers have been actively involved with performances of their works with the TCU Wind Symphony including Frank Ticheli, David Maslanka, Michael Colgrass, James Syler, James Stephenson, Eric Ewazen and others.
