TIM ISHII

Tim Ishii is one of the newest additions to the music faculty at UT-Arlington. Under his direction, the UTA Jazz Orchestra was the featured guest big band at the 2005 Coyote Jazz Festival in Weatherford, Texas where Tim was the featured artist/clinician with the Weatherford College Faculty Jazz Ensemble. In addition, Professor Ishii's UT-Arlington Jazz Orchestra was one of eight university jazz ensembles from throughout the United States that was selected to perform at the 2005 Addison Jazz Festival in Addison, Texas. Tim is sought after as a performer and clinician throughout the U.S. He has made presentations and performed at the Texas Music Educators Association Conference, conducted numerous high school all-region jazz bands, and in January 2006, was the guest conductor of the New Mexico All-State High School Jazz Ensemble. Tim maintains a busy freelance schedule and has performed with the Dallas Symphony Orchestra, Fort Worth Symphony Orchestra, and Texas Wind Symphony. He has played in the bands for numerous headliners including: Natalie Cole, The Temptations, Doc Severinson, Clark Terry, James Moody, Slide Hampton, and Bob Mintzer, to name a few. Mr. Ishii is a founding member of Thrascher, a contemporary saxophone quartet. The quartet has released two CDs in the past three years. Tim is an artist/clinician for Cannonball Musical Instruments.

Matthew McInturf is Professor of Music, Director of Bands and Director of the Center for Music Education at Sam Houston State University in Huntsville, Texas. He previously taught at Florida International University and in the public schools of Richardson, Texas. He holds a Bachelor of Music degree in Music Theory from the University of North Texas and a Master of Music in Composition from the University of Houston. Throughout his career, Mr. McInturf's ensembles have been recognized for their musical accomplishment. He has performed throughout the United States and recordings of his performances have been broadcast on National Public Radio. He has performed at the Texas Music Educators Association Convention in San Antonio, Texas and at the Southwest Regional Convention of the College Band Directors National Association with the SHSU Wind Ensemble. Mr. McInturf has served on the National Commissioning Committee of the College Band Directors National Association. He is a Past President of the Texas Bandmasters Association and serves as Region Officer in the Texas Music Educators Association. Mr. McInturf is active in the College Band Directors National Association, the World Association for Symphonic Bands and Ensembles and is a member of the College Music Society.
