


Honoring Doug's Spiritual Guidance and Support




NO JANUARY GRACE HIGHLIGHTS

On January 7, 2024, the Pastor Nominating Committee will present to the Grace Church Congregation its candidate to be the next pastor of Grace Church. The Rev. Dr. Owar Ojulu will be delivering the message during the worship service. At the conclusion of the service, a congregational meeting will be held in which the congregation will vote to accept this candidate.

We are so pleased and excited to be able to present Pastor Owar to you. We first became acquainted with him at the beginning of October when he self-referred himself to us, meaning he found our position opening and he felt called to respond. From the beginning, we realized how special he is. Owar came to the United States in 2008 from Ethiopia. He received a Bachelor of Biblical Theology in 2007; he attended Dubuque Theological Seminary where he received his Master of Divinity in 2012; and he received his Doctor of Ministry in 2018 from Sioux Falls Seminary. He served in ministry in Iowa, South Dakota and Minnesota before he was called to the Ebensburg and Colver churches in Redstone Presbytery. He has served there for four years. He is the Chairman of the Mission Committee in Redstone Presbytery, and his colleagues have said that he is truly a man of God and a joy to work with. Owar is married to his wife Apay, and they have 5 children, ages ranging from 22 years to 2-1/2 years.

We are very excited for all of you to meet Pastor Owar. We will be having an open house meetand-greet on Saturday, January 6, from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM in Cana Hall.
