What is NYC READS?

NYC Reads will bring science-of-reading and phonics-based learning methods to all public school students, starting with early childhood programs and elementary schools through high school graduation.

A strong early reading and writing program in kindergarten, first, and second grade that includes instruction in the five fundamentals of reading:

- Phonics: relationships between the letters of written language and the sounds of spoken language.
- Phonemic awareness: the ability to understand that spoken words are made up of individual sounds.
- Vocabulary: the meaning or definition of words.
- Fluency: the ability to read accurately with reasonable speed and expression.
- o Comprehension: the ability to understand and interpret what is read.



Curriculum Decisions: Elementary School

All NYCPS's will implement one of three comprehensive evidence-based curricula for reading instruction that includes grounding in phonics. **We will be implementing TWO curricular.**

- HMH Into Reading (spanish dual language elementary schools)
- Wit & Wisdom (Greatminds.org) (all other elementary schools)
