 - 13 categories of impairment
 - that "by reason thereof" require special education and related services
 - 504
 - Substantial limitation on a major life activity

FAPE

Free Appropriate Public Education

 Instruction must be 'specially designed' to meet a child with a disability's 'unique needs' through an individualized education program reasonably calculated to enable a child to make progress appropriate in light of the child's circumstances.
