Dear Sir:

How tough is a 14' McKee boat supposed to be?

With a crushed bow and shattered side, rub rails pulled loose to act as a second sea anchor, five men aboard –water, gas & supplies; is it supposed to withstand the hammering if 30' waves in a full gale for 37 hours and not disintegrate? Well, we thank God you build a boat with that hidden bonus of integrity that keep it intact in spite of the above abuse and misuse.

When my 47' motor sailer, the Tiki, foundered after 2 days in a full gale beating off the Grand Bahama Shoals, we took to the life boat. After we sent out our Mayday, we spent 2 hours putting gear aboard and where possible tying it down...


To stow these things, one man was aboard with two men pulling the McKee up to the stern and two men above slinging gear aboard. Time and again the stern rub rail of the ketch crashed down on the bow of the McKee—all 20 tons—splintering the bow and stern no matter how we tried to fend it off. The waves were 30 feet or higher, the wind at 60 on my anemometer – it was a wild sea. One side swipe splintered the right side of the bow sheering off a piece 10 inches by 2 feet from the outside fiberglass covering, exposing the flotation material...

As the U.S. Coast Guard said to my sons 24 hours after the Tiki sank, "there is no use our continuing this search; no small boat could possibly survive in the cross seas in a Gulf Stream gale of this magnitude." Little did they know of your great design, how well she responded to a quick turn of motor to avoid a cresting, crashing wave and how her structure could hold together under the incessant pounding of tremendous, solid seas.

We eventually ran out of gas...having traveled right through the teeth of the gale. Five hours later, 10 miles further out, and some 20 miles further north, we were picked up by the SS Texaco Nebraska and...taken aboard, two by stretcher, one unconscious and three of us still on our feet.

All of us are grateful I picked a McKee boat as a tender and life boat we're further grateful you people really know how to build a boat with that extra integrity that made it so much more durable than we could reasonably expect.

### **FLOTATION**

Most 18' boats require only 80 lbs of foam to meet U.S. Coast Guard requirements for level flotation and 125 pounds to fill the hull... but, we pack it in, under pressure using 200 lbs. That is more than two and a half times the requirement set by the U.S. Coast Guard. The foamed boat is also allowed to cure overnight in the mold. During our in-mold construction cycle, some competitor's molds have already built as many as 2 boats during the same period of time. That's why our dimensional stability is like no other boat on

Safety is the reason why each and every McKee Craft boat features our unsinkable construction. McKee Craft takes that requirement to the next level: our boats will not only float, but also remain upright in calm water, even if the boat is cut in half.

#### **UNMATCHED DURABILITY**

McKee Craft boats do not have stringers. We utilize a totally unique construction method we call "PBS," our Pressure
Bonding System. This unique method of construction allows the strength of the deck to combine with the strength of the hull, both complimenting each other, resulting in the most rugged hulls in the industry.

#### **BEAUTY IS MORE THAN SKIN DEEP**

Inside every McKee Craft is a story that you can't see. It is the passion that drives our team to design, engineer, and manufacture to the highest standards... the heart that understands the importance of family time, memories of time on the water, the first big catch....and the peace of mind knowing that your boat is safe and unsinkable.

### **HULL & DECK BOND**

The hull and deck are permanently bonded with ATC B39 bonding putty, which ensures a complete,rather than spot bond of the hull and deck. To properly secure factory installed equipment, 316 stainless steel screws and high strength composite backing materials such as 1/2" thick polyethylene or aluminum plating are utilized throughout McKee Craft's construction systems.


### THE "PBS" SYSTEM

Unlike other manufacturers, McKee Craft utilizes a unique method of injecting flotation foam into our boats. We use specially formulated polyurethane foam that expands to 50 times its original volume in less than a minute. The combination of heat and intense pressure chemically and mechanically bonds every square inch of the hull to every inch of the deck. The two pieces become one integral part. This added rigidity reduces hull noise, eliminates stress cracking and minimizes hull flex in rough seas.





### Typical Boat Construction The McKee Craft Difference



- Hull and deck are spot bonded, causing uneven support and unnecessary flex, making them susceptible to fatigue
- Stringer grid-supported hulls deform under hydraulic pressure, thus reducing speed and efficiency
- Large open voids between the hull and liner create unnecessary hull noise
- Secondary bonded stringer grid system relies primarily on mechanical bonding for strength
- Meets Coast Guard flotation requirements

- Hull and deck liner are completely bonded,creating a unitized structure for unmatched strength
- PBS construction resists hydraulic pressure equally, thus maintaining an efficient and fast hull shape



- The foam injection system eliminates voids between outer hull and liner, resulting in a quieter ride
- McKee Craft's hull technology eliminates the need for traditional stringers and provides a mechanical and chemical bond for unsurpassed strength
- Exceeds Coast Guard requirements with up to 3 times the flotation of regular boats



McKee Craft utilizes ISO-NPG gelcoat, which has high flex properties that are resistant to cracking, and titanium dioxide pigments that are the most UV stable pigments available. This keeps the finish and colors looking beautiful for years to come.



The fiberglass ISO/DCPD ratio is precision machine metered. Highly trained lamination technicians handroll the fiberglass to create uniform, consistent hull thickness.



Top quality transom composites are embedded into the wet laminate on the hull. Then the composite transom is completely encapsulated in fiberglass for added strength.



Each McKee Craft hull stays in the mold for a full 48 hours to ensure a full cure for the best dimensional stability and cosmetic finish. Many manufacturers cycle molds twice a day or more which can hamper quality, distort or even twist hulls.



Fuel tanks are high quality welded aluminum with interior baffles to keep the fuel from shifting too quickly which might affect the balance of the boat. All below deck fuel tanks are foamed in place and primed with zinc chromate for greater resistance



Quality and craftsmanship are builtin from the start. Where you can see it, and where you can't, you can rest assure that quality is inside every inch of your McKee Craft boat.
