**CALL TO ORDER:** The President and the Board of Trustees held the regular scheduled meeting on Tuesday, April 26, 2022 at the Southern View Municipal Building, 3410 South Fifth Street, Southern View, Illinois. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by President Patsche, followed by Roll call and the Pledge of Allegiance.

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**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** Rick Allen addressed the board regarding the Village sign on 2<sup>nd</sup> Street. Rick also stated that there are a lot of sticks in the Park, potholes in the parking lot of the park and potholes that need filled throughout the Village. Rick also addressed 8-10 water heaters on Carman 4 doors north of him and he would like someone to have them removed. President Patsche stated that Public Works is doing the best they can, we have had several employees out for medical and vacation. President Patche is working on an estimate of the costs to repair all the roads and from there the Village can decide what roads we can afford to do at that time.

Tim Fuhrmann addressed the board regarding the drainage issues that is still going on at Straight Street. The collectors seem to be full of debris, all plugged up that no water is going down them. Tim stated that Kevin Kuhn our Village Engineer stated at the last meeting he would be in contact with the company to finish the area but he hasn't seen anyone yet. President Patsche stated unfortunately Kevin had another meeting tonight and that he would contact Kevin and see where they are. Tim also stated he has concerns with UHaul putting in a road that comes out on 11<sup>th</sup> Street. Tim expressed his concern that folks will be able to walk right up on his property then and he would like to see some kind of fencing or barrier on the lot to prevent people coming through. Tim spoke to someone at UHaul and they informed him with the cost rising at this time they are tilling it up and planting grass seed.
