- Promoting firearms safety through match competition and instruction regarding the maintenance and use of early American firearms
- Educating the community regarding the region's rich history, early American trades, crafts, and skills, such as gun making, weaving, food gathering and preparation, bead work, tracking, shelter building, self-sufficient trekking, and similar activities. This education is done in a participatory, collaborative, and hands-on manner through clinics, exhibits, re-enactments, rendezvous, show and tells, and similar events
