Archbishop to Consecrate the Archdiocese to the Immaculate Heart of Mary at 66th Annual Living Rosary: In celebration of the Fatima Centennial, Archbishop Kurtz will be giving the main address and homily at the 66th Annual Living Rosary event beginning at 2:30pm on Sunday, October 8th, at Trinity High School's Steinhauer Gymnasium (near corner of Shelbyville Road & St. Matthew's Ave). He will speak about "The Relevance of the Fatima Message for Today" and will also consecrate the Archdiocese in a special way to the Blessed Mother who always leads us to her son. The event will also feature a solemn rosary made of children from throughout the Archdiocese, a concert by the Holy Name Band, devotional prayers and hymns, and a crowning of the statue of Our Lady of Fatima. To help us prepare beforehand and reflect on it afterwards, Archbishop Kurtz has written a letter that summarizes and presents a pastoral letter that his friend, Bishop Johnston, wrote about the notion of Consecration to Mary.
