**Office of Multicultural Ministry:** The Archdiocese of Louisville's Office of Multicultural Ministry will host its 36<sup>th</sup> Annual Citywide Kwanzaa Celebration on Thursday, December 28, 2017, 5:30 p.m. at the Catholic Enrichment Center, 3146 West Broadway, in Louisville. This is a community-wide family event filled with music, prayer, African drumming, food, a celebration of history and much more. Kwanzaa, which means "first fruits of the harvest" in the African language Kiswahili, is a seven-day harvest festival celebrated December 26 – January 1. This is a celebration of family, community and culture, not a religious holiday. Kwanzaa was founded in 1966 by Dr. Maulana Karenga, Professor of Africana Studies at California State University-Long Beach.
