Pastor's Report, Review/Approval of Minutes:

Finance (Diana Faue)

- The November meeting dealt largely with planning for Advent and Christmas, and things went well.
- Moving to three Masses has caused some problems with scheduling ministers, and these are still being worked out.
- Our next meeting will be January 30.

Parish Life (Joy Martin):

Community Outreach – Sue Balter

- Sue communicated with Mary Anne Cecil about the 3 initiatives - Healthcare Readifest, Community Baby Shower, and Community Angel Tree. Mary Anne Cecil has chosen to continue these 3 initiatives.
- During the Parish Council meeting, I was informed that this will change.

Community Angel Tree – Mary Anne Cecil

- All Saints assisted 18 children

Welcomers/Parish Directory– Barbara “Bonnie” Pass

- They had no attendees for the November Informational Meetings.
- 1 family of 3 adults and 1 baby attended the December Informational Meeting.
- The Ables family joined the parish on December 3rd. They will present them with 2 gifts since they are in 2 households.
- Although additional Informational Meetings were scheduled for 2018 (January 7, February 4, March 4, April 1, and May 6), they had several meetings with no attendees, so the Welcomers Committee is considering meeting with interested parties on an as needed basis.
- They need to create new booklets for the Informational Meetings since so many changes have taken place. Their supply has been depleted. They need to create the new booklets as soon as possible because there is nothing to give to the attendees of the Informational Meetings.
- The Informational Meeting Date Cards on the table are not being picked up, so they will discontinue them.

Stewardship – Bonnie Pass

- The Stewardship Ministry has had no meetings. A sub-committee has been formed for fundraising, and Father Johnny has asked Gina Nelson to be the co-chair and to recruit a couple of volunteers. Gina found 4 volunteers and the Fundraising Committee will meet.
- Bonnie attended the Discernment Meeting a few weeks ago where one of the attendees mentioned that they were not aware of the committees/ministries available for volunteers of the parish. Bonnie will update the Ministry Opportunities brochure and leave them on the tables behind the pews, available to everyone. We should print no more than 10 at a time due to constant changes.
- I was later informed that Stewardship was transferred to the Finance Committee.
- During Parish Council meeting, I was informed that there will be Stewardship A and Stewardship B.

Parish Yard Sale – Barbara Shirley

- Confirmed that she will only have a one day yard sale.

- During Parish Council Meeting, I was informed that Parish Yard Sale will be transferred to the Finance Committee.

Respect Life – Kelly Keller

- Respect Life have had activity but I have not received a report yet.

Newsletter – Betty Darnell

- Informed Betty that we are waiting for the new weekly bulletins to start and that we will look at doing a year in review newsletter.
- During The Parish Council meeting, I was informed that the Newsletter will be transferred to the Communications Committee under Daryl Wertz.

Social Hospitality – Kelly Eiden

- Sunday, December 3rd - Open house was held at the apartment upstairs and refreshments were served in the parish hall. Subway sandwiches, cookies and drinks were served. About 50 people attended.
- Sunday, December 10 – Fr. Johnny’s installation. Suzanne Dewitt with St Michael the Archangel, asked All Saints parishioners to bring a vegetable or salad dish for the potluck. About 30 parishioners attended.

- December 16, a bereavement meal was served for the family and friends of Patrick Maciejewski, brother of Tommy Mac. I was out of state attending my aunt’s funeral, when I learned about needing a bereavement meal. I was informed that Yvonne Nieman was gracious to volunteer to lead the event. Once I returned, I communicated with some parishioners. Kenny Harryman accepted to chair the Bereavement Meal committee and the members list was forwarded to her.
- Yvonne Niemann has agreed to co-chair with Kenny Harryman.

Healing Blanket – Patti Willey

- Patti is excited about leading this committee and will also make Newborn Baby Blankets.

Digital Media –

- We have uploaded the weekly bulletins as they are received.
- We received a calendar in the correct orientation and were able to upload to the website. We have not been receiving Worship ministry schedule so we are unable to update.
