The Town of Bethel Transfer Station is owned and operated by the Town.
This is NOT a County facility.

Car Permit Required All Year – Free car permits can be obtained from Bethel Town Hall.
Need Car Registration for permit. If you already have a car permit you do not need a new one.
No Special Permit is required for Clean-Up Day

All items must be sorted and disposed of in proper waste containers.

Tires – Four free per household, standard size car tire only. Rates apply for all other sizes.

Bulk Waste – couches, chairs, rugs, outdoor and indoor furniture, tables, yard toys, mattresses, etc. go into the bulk waste container. SORT YOUR RECYCLABLES. **FREE!**

Refrigeration Units –\$10.00 each (refrigerators, freezers, air-conditioners, etc.)

Computers, Monitors, TVs, Radios, VCR/DVD Players - Free all year. See attendant!

Metal: B-B-Q grills, water heaters, chairs, shelving, empty propane tanks, clothes dryers/washing machines, bicycles, pipes, swing sets, lawnmowers. **Free All Year!**

Empty Paint Cans: Must be **EMPTY!** Metal cans go in metal pile. Plastic cans go in recycle bin. If you have paint cans with paint, remove the lid, place in sunshine away from children, pets, and water to evaporate paint.

Salvation Army Bins for clothes and small items – **Free all Year!**

Recyclables (Glass, Tin and Plastic ONLY): NO PLASTIC BAGS. **Free All Year!**

Newspaper, cardboard and mixed paper can be placed in same container. **Free all Year!**

These items are garage - Do Not Place in Recycle: Styrofoam, plate glass, ceramics, plastic wrap or bags, rubber hoses, plastic toys, polystyrene “to go” food containers.

Car Batteries & Used Car Oil Free All Year: Must be disposed of in proper container.

NO household garbage – must pay regular fee – prepay with coupons and save!

NO Construction or Demolition materials of any kind!

County will have a separate Hazardous Waste (paint, poison, et.) Clean-up day in Summer!
