
NEW SCHOOL REPS.

Election year 2024! This election year will be one to remember.

PASR and DCPASR voters should consider candidates in the primary election who will stand for their interests in November's election.

School retiree voters should give serious consideration to choosing candidates that will support **HB1416** for pension increases for <u>Pre-act 9</u> retirees.

Public Education is fighting the politicians who want dramatic increases in school choice for students. Public Education must survive the election process to help keep our pension system from going broke. It is important for school retirees to vote in large numbers to show the politicians that we care about public education.

Remember, charter schools, cyber schools and private schools that receive taxpayer money are not regulated by the STATE. Attendance is regulated in these schools. The STATE does not audit the books in these schools, which leaves us with no idea as to how our tax dollars are being spent.

In closing, we must encourage our members to vote for candidates who will work for us to improve our everyday living. Remember, your future depends on the right candidate you help to elect to bring about the needed changes for the right political leadership to get the job done.
