





SOCIETY ACT CONSTITUTION

- 1. The name of the society is Sechelt Groves Society
- 2. The purpose(s) of the society (are):
 - a) To work to preserve, enhance and maintain selected natural recreational areas of Sechelt and its surrounds and in particular, but not limited to, those areas colloquially known as the Sechelt Heritage Forest and the Hidden Grove;
 - To organize for the development of amenities within the designated areas for the access and enjoyment of the general public, those with physical handicaps and school children;
 - To promote and develop amenities that will aid in the education of the public and particularly school children, in the wonders of and value of such preserved natural recreation areas;
 - d) To assist the local tourism industry to promote and utilize the areas provided such use is not in conflict with the main purpose as set out in section 2 a) above as determined by the membership and executive:
 - To raise funds as needed for the furtherance of the activities of the society without purpose of gain for its members, and any profits or other assets of the organization shall be used solely to promote its objectives;
 - To provide similar or related services as recommended by the membership and executive.

BYLAWS

The bylaws of the society are those set out in Schedule B to the Society Act, with the following variations, deletions and additions:

- 1. Bylaw 4 of Part 2- Membership be revised to:
- (4) A person may apply to the directors for membership in the society and on acceptance of the directors may become a member by paying dues at the prevailing rate(s). A new member is not entitled to vote at a general meeting until (10) days after becoming a member.
- 2. Bylaws (1) and (2)of Part 25, be revised to:
- 1) No fewer than Five (5) and no more than Eight (8) members elected by the members, and the immediate past president, if he is not otherwise a director, shall be the directors of the society. The directors shall, as soon as practicable following the annual general meeting but within 10 days, elect, from among themselves the officers of the Society who shall be, a president, a vice president (who may be considered to be in line of succession to the presidency but not confirmed), a secretary and a treasurer.
 - (2) The number of directors may be changed from time to time at a general meeting.
- 3. Bylaws (1), (2) and (4) of Part 26 be revised to
- (1) The terms of directors shall be two years and they shall retire from office upon expiry of their terms at the general meeting when successors have been elected.
- (2) The terms of officers shall be one year, and they shall retire from office at each general meeting when successors have been elected.
- 4) The directors shall prepare at least 30 days prior to the annual general meeting, a slate of nominees for the positions of all directors and shall include the slate in the annual general meeting announcement. Included in any slate prepared shall be no fewer than two nominees from the Board of the Sandy Hook Community Association who have been selected

by the current directors in consultation with the president of the Sandy Hook Community Association and who have confirmed their willingness to serve as directors of the society. Should one or more of the Sandy Hook Community Association board members selected decline to serve then replacement director nominees may be chosen from the society membership.

- 4. Bylaw (1) of Part 28 is deleted
- 5. Bylaw (1) of Part 37 be revised to:
- (1) Questions arising at a meeting of the directors and committee of directors must be decided by a majority of votes. Any director abstaining from a vote is, for the purposes of that vote, not counted as present and not making up the total for a majority.
- 6. Part 43 be revised to:

The treasurer must

- (a) deposit all funds of the society in a bank or banks to be named by the directors;
- (b) pay all bills only on the basis of written documentation, and by cheques signed by two or more of four authorized signatories:
- (c) keep the financial records, including books of account, necessary to comply with the Society Act;
 - (d) render financial statements to the directors, members and others when required;
 - (e) maintain a register of members in lieu of the secretary if so agreed by the Board.
- 7. Bylaw (2) of Part 44 be revised to
- (2) If a secretary treasurer holds office, the total number of directors must not be fewer than 5 or the greater number that may have been determined under bylaw 25.
- 8. Bylaw (51) of Part 10 be revised to
- (51) Bylaws 52 to 57 inclusive apply only if the society is required or has resolved to have an auditor but in any event a thorough review of all the society's financial records shall be made once each year by such person or persons as the directors shall designate.
- 9. Bylaws (58) and (59) of Part 11 be revised to
- (58) A notice may be given to a member, either personally or by regular mail or by email to the member at the member's registered address or last declared email address.
- (59) A notice sent by regular mail is deemed to have been given on the second day following the day on which the notice is posted, and in proving that notice has been given, it is sufficient to prove the notice was properly addressed and put in a Canadian post office receptacle. A notice sent by email is deemed to have been delivered on the day on which the notice is posted as evidenced by the senders email records.
- 10. Bylaw 61 of Part 12 be revised to
- (61) On being admitted to membership, each member is entitled to, and the society must, on request, give the member without charge, a copy of the constitution and bylaws of the society.
