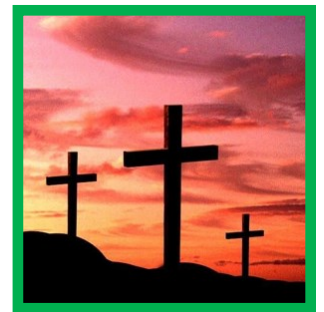


2 Corinthian 5:18-21

Spain**



It is hard to believe it has been 5 years since our first visit to Spain. So much has happened since then. We met Lazaro in Kenya and have been discipling him. We went back to Spain, then did the internship in Germany for a year, got shut down because of Covid, then went to Chiapas, Mexico for 3 months. In October last year started at Mission Bell Resort until April, then Campers for Christ for the summer, etc.

Finally we have the go ahead to go back to Spain.

We have flights leaving Jan 10 and will return April 4, 2023. We want to reconnect with old friends and get some of the paperwork we needed for the long term visa accomplished. We hope to start a Charis Bible Study.

As you recall we ended up in Spain because Wayne had a visitation from the Lord earlier in his life that said he would go to Africa by way of Spain. When the Lord led us to Roquetas de Mar, we found over 100 square miles of green houses with workers from all over the world working there, many of them from African countries. Africa in Spain!

It is never easy for us to leave our family and friends here in Texas but I try to remember the scripture in **Luke 18:29-30** ²⁹ **And He said to them, "I assure you and most solemnly say to you, there is no one who has left house or wife or brothers or parents or children for the sake of the kingdom of God, ³⁰ who will not receive many times as much in this present age and in the age to come, eternal life."**



When I read this scripture, it makes me tear up. I think it is partly the thought of leaving those we love and all that we will miss. But also the joy of bringing others to know the Lord and His love, promises and eternal life.

While we are in Spain, we will be staying at the same apartment we stayed in first time which is 500 EU a month. The cost of things like gas have gone up. Thankfully the exchange rate from the Euro to the dollar is better now. We are praying for a good rate for a rental car which as of now will be about \$1000.00 per month. We may try to buy a cheap car when we are there instead but for now that is what we expect. We still have to cover other monthly expenses both in Spain and the USA.

We were able to use the vouchers from the Mexico trip so it made the flights very reasonable and they are already covered. We still have the money we saved for the required visa but don't want to have to dip into that as we will still need it to apply for the Visa. Please pray that God will provide all we need. We covet your prayers and support. Please ask God what is your role in missions. Some are called to go, some are called to pray and some are called to send. Which part are you?

We are looking forward to exciting things to come.
