I know the Lord has been dealing with me about my health, but it took this to really get my attention. I am, through His grace, trying to lose the 60 lbs. they required. I have already lost about 12!! To be honest, it is hard to fight discouragement. Yet the Lord keeps reminding me of His faithfulness. With all the things happening in the world with the Coronavirus, it may have been God's protection not allowing us to go to Spain now. Most of the organizations we have worked with are shut down. We wouldn't be able to be very effective even if we were there.

We decided to check out some other places to share the Gospel in case the door continues to be closed to Spain. We really want to be on the mission field and be good stewards of your seeds. We have been saving all the donations given. We want to be ready when the Lord sends us out. We do tithe on the money and use some for expenses like the newsletter and receipts. The rest is waiting for us to go. We finally got enough required for the visa with the monthly donations coming in.

Our home church has a relationship with a ministry called ByGrace which is an orphanage and school in Ngong, Kenya, Africa. We have corresponded with them and they suggested we visit them from June through September to see if this is where God was calling us. We will check it out if the door to Spain is still closed by then. We will also be looking for other open doors. We ask that you pray for clear direction. We still see the need in Spain, but we are willing to go where the Lord sends us.

No matter where we end up, we will still try to set up Discipleship Evangelism Classes and Charis Bible Studies with the people in the area and share the same message of God's love and grace that we hoped to share in Spain. God loves every nation!
